Your building was inspected on September 28, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on November 28, 2012 at 1:00PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 2. MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.(REDUCE STORAGE IN THE BASEMENT AND MAINTAIN THE REMAINING STORAGE IN AN ORDERLY MANNER.)
- 3. SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide An Equal Opportunity Employer

and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. (GARAGE NEEDS SUBSTANTIAL REPAIRS OR CONSIDER ITS REMOVAL.)

- 4. SPLC 71.01 Provide address numbers on building (front and rear)
- 5. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. (REPAIR OPEN SIDING AT THE REAR OF THE BUILDING WHERE A PREVIOUS DECK ONCE WAS.)

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
