UPDATED PER LEGISLATIVE APPEAL
Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 1596 HEWITT AVE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 31, 2025, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A reinspection will be made on February 12, 2025, at 1:00 pm or the property vacated in accordance with the deadline per January 26, 2024, Legislative Appeal result.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - East side staircase - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33(2) - Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. Every outside stair, porch and deck shall be constructed safely and shall be capable of supporting imposed loads as determined in the building code and shall be kept in a professional state of maintenance and repair with proper anchorage. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Have a licensed contractor submit plans to the city for work made to fire escape stairwell. Permits are needed for this work and need approval.
2. Interior - Throughout - SPLC 62.101 - Use of this property does not conform to zoning ordinance. Discontinue unapproved use or call DSI Zoning at (651) 266-8989 to convert to legal use.

Conditional use permit for use as a rooming house includes conditions limits to 8 female students from Hamline University. Property is no longer being rented to the female sorority, therefore is no longer a rooming house. De-convert to R3- single family house, meet current zoning conditions or apply obtain zoning approval for current use.

3. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke alarm affidavit and return it to this office.
