Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 305 EDMUND AVE Ref. # 112962

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on May 6, 2013, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A reinspection will be made on May 21, 2013 at 1:30 PM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 2nd floor Bathroom SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private hand sink. This work may require a permit(s). Call LIEP at (651) 266-9090.
- 2. Bathrooms Throughout SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water. Repair or replace flooring in bathroom.
- 3. Exterior All Yards SPLC 34.08 (6), 34.31 (4) Remove the accumulation of exterior storage that creates a nuisance or harbors rodents.
- 4. Exterior Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass. Repair or replace broken windows.

- 5. Garage SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition. - Replace garage door.
- 6. Interior Basement SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 7. Kitchen SPLC 34.14 (2) c Provide or replace the duplex convenience outlet with ground fault protection within 3 feet of the basin on an adjacent wall in all bathrooms. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 8. Throughout MSFC 315.2 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.
- 9. Throughout MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.
- 10. Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. Finish repairing and paint the walls.
- 11. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.
 Repair hole in 2nd floor hallway. Repair or replace kitchen flooring.
