NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND LICENSES

Dear Licensee:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend suspension of the Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer – Each Additional Vehicle licenses held by Xtreme Tree Team, Inc. d/b/a Xtreme Tree. The recommendation is based on the following information:

On July 18, 2018, you were sent a letter from the Department of Safety and Inspection (DSI) stating they would unable to complete renewal of your Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer — Each Additional Vehicle licenses because you failed to provide all required information to maintain the license. You were asked to complete the following actions by August 6, 2018:

- 1. Provide evidence of insurance issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in the State of Minnesota insuring said applicant in a sum of at least one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) for bodily injuries to or death of any person or persons not covered by the workers' compensation law and a sum of at least one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) for damage to or destruction of property.
- 2. Obtain inspection approval for the vehicle(s) used in the operation of your business. You may contact Ross Haddow at (651) 266-9143 or ross.haddow@ci.stpaul.mn.us to arrange for this approval.

A current MN DOT inspection report may be submitted with future renewals of a previously inspected and licensed vehicle (unless changes have been made to the vehicle or is otherwise required by DSI). DSI records show the following vehicles need a MN DOT Inspection report submitted:

DSI records show you submitted \$263.00 on April 12, 2018 to renew your licenses. However as of today you have not submitted the required insurance information and current MN DOT inspection reports to re-license existing vehicles.

In addition to the suspension of your Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer – Each Additional Vehicle licenses, per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office will also recommend a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information to maintain your license.

You have four (4) options to proceed:

- If you do not contest the imposition of the proposed adverse action, you may do nothing. If I have not heard
 from you by Monday, September 24, 2018, I will presume that you have chosen not to contest the proposed
 adverse action, and the matter will be placed on the October 10, 2018 City Council Consent Agenda for
 approval of the proposed remedy.
- You can submit current MN DOT inspection reports and insurance information listed above directly to DSI at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than Monday, September 24, 2018. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Submission of the required MN DOT inspection reports and insurance information will be considered a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 3. If you wish to admit the facts but contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council, you will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting the facts and requesting a public hearing no later **Monday**, **September 24**, **2018**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council to determine whether to suspend your Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer Each Additional Vehicle licenses and impose the \$500.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 4. If you no longer wish to do business in the City of Saint Paul, you will need to complete and return the attached REQUEST TO CANCEL LICENSE with the CITY OF SAINT PAUL to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday**, **September 24, 2018**.

If you have not contacted me by Monday, September 24, 2018, I will assume that you do not contest the suspension of your Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer – Each Additional Vehicle licenses and imposition of a \$500.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the October 10, 2018 City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
