Your building was inspected on February 21, 2013 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

### A re-inspection will be made on March 21, 2013 at 1:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. <u>1st Floor Sunroom MSFC 605.1</u> Repair or replace damaged lighting fixture. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 2. <u>Basement Bathroom SPLC 34.14 (3), MPC 4715.200.T</u> Provide and maintain a window or approved ventilation system in all bathrooms.

- 3. <u>Basement Kitchenette MSFC 605.1</u> Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 4. <u>Basement MSFC 605.5</u> Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 5. <u>Basement MSBC -Section 105.1 Permits Required.</u> Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. Work being done requires a permit.
  - -Obtain applicable plumbing, electrical, building permits for renovations previously completed.
- 6. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 7. <u>SPLC 39.02(c)</u> Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
