 - There is a large SUV with a blown tire parked on the grass.
- 2. Interior Basement Door MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.
 - There is a latch on the outside part of the basement door.
- 3. Interior Basement MSFC 315.2 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.-

- 4. Interior Basement MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials
- 5. Interior Bathroom MSFC 308.2.1 No person shall throw or place, or cause to be thrown or placed, a lighted match, cigar, cigarette, matches, or other flaming or glowing substance or object on any surface or article where it can cause an unwanted fire.-There were burn marks discovered on the bathroom floor.
- 6. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.

 There are various spots throughout the house that has walls with unfinished repairs and painting.
- 7. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.
- 8. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.

 The ceiling throughout the house has large dark yellow stained, black spots and markings. Paint the ceiling.
