## **CORRECTION NOTICE - COMPLAINT INSPECTION**

Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on April 25, 2024 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately. **A re-inspection will be made on or after May 28, 2024.** 

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- SPLC 40.01 Fire Certificate of Occupancy.
  - (a) All existing buildings in the city are required to have and maintain a fire certificate of occupancy, issued by the department of safety and inspections. The fire certificate of occupancy shall be an indication that the building meets, at the time of inspection, all relevant codes to maintain the health, safety and welfare of the building's occupants and the general public.
  - (b) Provisional fire certificate of occupancy. When an owner-occupied dwelling changes to a rental dwelling unit, the owner of the dwelling must submit a completed application for a provisional certificate of occupancy, a completed owner's self-evaluation affidavit and pay the fee for a provisional certificate of occupancy within thirty (30) days of the change in use.

Per information provided during Fire Department response to the building, owner is no longer living at the property. Property is no longer owner occupied and must be registered for Provisional Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

2. MSFC 604.1 - Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. - *Repair* 

damaged wiring on front exterior wall where struck by vehicle. Breaker to remain off until wiring has been repaired under permit.

- 3. SPLC 34.09 (1)(2)(a), 34.33 (1)(b) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Repair damaged front exterior wall where struck by vehicle.
- 4. SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.34(1) Repair and maintain the damaged structural member. This repair may require a building permit, call DSI at (651) 266-8989. *Repair damaged structural members of wall under permit where struck by vehicle.*

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
