A re-inspection was made on your building on October 26, 2017, in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on or after November 16, 2017.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 63.501(b)(c) (b)Accessory buildings, structures or uses shall not be erected in or established in a required yard except a rear yard.
  - (C) Accessory buildings shall be set back at least three (3) feet from all interior lot lines. Move shed at least 3 feet from the property line and to the backyard, or remove the shed.
