As we were securing the residence, myself and other Officers went into the basement. It should be noted that before we had searched the basement we had already been in the residence for several minutes due to a loose pit bull that we were able to secure in a empty bathroom. We opened the door to the unlighted basement and announced ourselves. We then continued down the stairs. As I neared the bottom of the stairs, using my flashlight, I could see a b/m, later identified as IRELAND, THOMAS KWAME ZOLO (DOB 07/17/87), to the left of the stairs. I gave him verbal commands to show me his hands and get on the ground. IRELAND took a step forward to the bottom of the stairs and got onto his hands and knees but would not go to the ground which was preventing me and the other officers to continue off the stairs and safely secure the basement. I put my right foot onto his back and pushed him to the ground and continued past him to secure the basement. I could hear Officer Mahowald and Officer Raichert struggling with IRELAND while giving him verbal commands to put his hands behind his back. (see supplemental reports)

After the residence was secure I spoke to the three residents: BOLTON, MARCUS ALLEN (DOB 12/18/85), HARSTON, KEAVIN KEANDRE (DOB 04/20/87), DAVIS, RONALD EARL (DOB 08/19/51). I asked each of them how often they smoke marijuana in the residence and they all said "everyday" and that they often have friends over and allow them to also smoke marijuana. BOLTON (cit #911135657), HARSTON (cit #911135656) and DAVIS (cit #911135655) were all issued citations for operating a disorderly house.

I Officer Mahowald Sqd 675, am currently assigned to the East FORCE Unit. The FORCE Unit investigates street level narcotics, problem properties and other quality of life complaints.

Today I assisted Officer Raichert Sqd 673, with the execution of a narcotics search warrant at 1035 Magnolia. We briefed for the warrant and a plan was devised to make entry using marked/uniformed officers to make initial contact with the occupants, then East FORCE Officers would enter, secure the occupants and execute the warrant.

Upon entry we identified ourselves as the police and that we had a search warrant. We found 2 adults in the living room, 3 adults and one juvenile in the n/w bedroom, one adult was found in the bathroom. While we secured the occupants on the main level we held at the door leading to the basement from the kitchen.

Once the main level occupants were secured, Officer A. Bailey, Raichert, J. Reginek and I then entered the basement.

There Officer A. Bailey made contact with a b/m later ID'd as: IRELAND, THOMAS KWAME ZOLO dob: 7-17-87, who was hiding in the dark basement. Officer A. Bailey ordered him to the floor and IRELAND went to his hands and knees but refused to go all the way down. Officer Bailey pushed Ireland to the ground completely. Once Officer Bailey passed IRELAND, again attempted to get up. Officer Raichert then forced Ireland back onto the floor, there I saw that his hands were under his upper torso out of my view. I gave him loud verbal commands to show his hands and to put them behind his back, he brought his hands into view however refused to put them behind his back. I then pinned him to the floor by putting my right knee in between his shoulders on his back. I gave him more loud verbal commands to put his hands behind his back, again he

I told him that I would Tase him if he didn't put his hands behind his back, at this point he brought his hands along his upper torso and began to push against the floor it what appeared to be an attempt to get up to fight or flee, not knowing if he had a weapon concealed on his person, I drew my dept issued Taser X-26 (X00-385451), removed the cartridge, activated it and delivered a drive stun to IRELAND's upper back as a distraction technique and to gain pain compliance. Due to information gathered prior to the execution of the warrant regarding the presence of small children and multiple aggressive dogs on scene we used a marked Squad 363 (Snedden/C. McGuire) to make the initial contacts with the residents of 1035 Magnolia Ave E to prevent injury to the children and occupants.

Once Squad 363 had made entry into the home we entered behind them and announce to the residents that we were executing the search warrant.

We cleared the main level of the home without incident. We then cleared the basement. We opened the door to the basement and clearly announced ourselves as the Police and that we had a search as we went down the stairs to the basement. The basement was completely dark with only our flashlights illuminating our view. We continued announcing our presence and as we approached the bottom of the stairs a black male, Thomas Ireland, appeared. We ordered Ireland to show his hands and get on the ground and he did so slowly. As Officer A. Bailey passed Ireland I saw Ireland put his hands under his body and start to push up from the ground and get up. I gave Ireland several loud and clear commands to get back on the ground and show his hands. Ireland refused to follow my direction and continued to get up almost to his feet. Ireland was ignoring several officers commands, and repeatedly told us he dropped his glasses. Despite repeated loud verbal commands, Ireland would not put his hands behind his back, but instead began reaching around the ground near him claiming he was looking for his glasses. Due to Ireland not following my direction and for Officer safety I delivered two kicks to Ireland's right leg causing him to fall back to the ground. When on the ground, Ireland still refused to show his hands and was tased by Officer Mahowald. We were then able to get Ireland handcuffed behind his back allowing us to clear the rest of the basement.

Pursuant to the warrant the following, the following items were recovered: Three bags of marijuana, two .22 caliber rounds, two narcotics scales, and mail addressed to Keavin Harston(See supplement by Ofc. Mahowald).

We (Off. A. Henry & Off. J. Mollner - SQD#360) were sent to the rear (alley) of 1035 Magnolia on a Gold Cadillac illegally parked, blocking the alley, and the COMP believed people had been doing drugs and sleeping in it.

When we arrived we found a Gold Cadillac, bearing MN PLT 263-NWX, parked facing W/B behind the garage at 1029 Magnolia. The vehicle was blocking the alley illegally and it had yellow 2002 tabs on the front plate and blue 2003 tabs on the rear. We ran the PLT and it listed to LICHTENBERG, at a MPLWD address.

The vehicle was unoccupied and was covered with a light dusting of snow which gave us the impression no one had opened the doors since it started snowing earlier in the day. We looked closer at the rear, blue 2003 tab, bearing tab #C 2795323, and we could see it was ripped on the right side. We knew from prior experience that this often happened when someone tore a tab off another vehicle and then attempted to re-attach it to another car plate.

We ran the tab #C 2795323 via CH5 and they advised that tab belonged on MN PLT DHG-718, a 1985 Honda Civic (1500). The tab was not listed as being reported stolen which we knew to be common given the fact people often don't notice a tab missing from their vehicle(s). Because of this we decided to recover the plate and have the vehicle towed.

As we were seated in our SQD behind the car preparing a tow report a W/M came out from the driveway leading up to the garage at 1029 Magnolia and asked what we were doing. We asked him if he knew who owned the car and he replied, "My cousin." We asked if his cousin was home and he said he would go and get him. A moment later another W/M came out to the alley and ID'd himself as the R/O of MN PLT 263-NWX, saying he was LICHTENBERG. I asked LICHTENBERG if he owned the car (we already knew he was listed as the R/O) and he said he was. I pointed at the front plate bearing the September 2002 (yellow) tab and said, "Did you know your plates are expired?" LICHTENBERG said "Yes". I did not mention the improper 2003 tab on the back PLT.

I asked LICHTENBERG if he had an ID so I could verify he was the R/O and he said he had one in "the house." I told LICHTENBERG if he wanted to grab it he could and LICHTENBERG left the alley on his own, went in to the house and came back out with a booking photo of himself bearing

As I got next to our car I saw LICHTENBERG was not keeping pace with me and when I turned around to see why I noticed LICHTENBERG looking around. LICHTENBERG's eyes were moving rapidly and he appeared nervous. I recognized that behavior to often be an indicator of someone preparing to flee. I said, "Relax we just gotta verify you are the owner." and LICHTENBERG appeared to settle down a little bit. Because we suspected LICHTENBERG of the GM crime of Evade State Tax (tabs on car), he had ID'd himself via a booking photo, and he was now acting nervous I asked LICHTENBERG if he had any weapons on him. LICHTENBERG said he did not. I said, "You don't mind if I check do you?" and he said no. I did not make LICHTENBERG face away from me with his hands interlaced on his head because I did not want to make him anymore nervous than he already appeared. I just casually began to squeeze his coat pockets and then went to his jeans pockets as he stood next to me. When I squeezed the outside of LICHTENBERG's right, front jean pocket I felt a hard rectangular object I thought might be a pocket knife. I said, "Is that a pocket knife?" and LICHTENBERG sighed loudly and began to back away from me. I said, "Relax" and he turned away from me and started to head back towards his car.

I said "Stop" and without looking back at me, LICHTENBERG said, "I'm just gonna start the car." I said stop again and he began to walk faster away from me. I said, "Hey stop!" and LICHTENBERG then broke into a dead run and began to flee, west to the front of his car. As LICHTENBERG began to turn S/B towards the back yard he reached with his right hand towards his hip area and then swung his arm up, like a basketball "sky-hook", and he threw something in a plastic bag over his head, S/B onto the garage roof of 1229 Magnolia. Off. Mollner saw this throw also. LICHTENBERG then ran S/B through the back yard of 1029 Magnolia and I gave pursuit on foot. I yelled out at least three additional times, "Stop you are under arrest!" as I chased LICHTENBERG.

LICHTENBERG ran S/B, through the back yard of 1029 Magnolia and then ran S/B along the west side of 1029 Magnolia. I chased LICHTENBERG on foot and as he got to the front (south end) of the house he appeared to slip in the fresh snow and then started to turn back towards me with his hands out in front of him. I yelled for him to get on the ground and when I caught up to him I tackled him down in the yard.

I yelled for LICHTENBERG to put his hands behind his back but he began to pull them up underneath of him, by his chest as if to try and roll me off of him. As LICHTENBERG's right arm (bent at the elbow) began to push his upper body up, away from the ground by the forearm I believed this was exactly what he was trying to do. I then struck LICHTENBERG in the right tricep with a closed fist. The strike made his arm buckle underneath him. When the arm gave away the strike followed through and resulted in my striking LICHTENBERG with a diminished punch in the jaw/ear area.

The strike prevented LICHTENBERG from pushing me off and I again yelled for him to put his hands behind his back because he was under arrest. LICHTENBERG did not comply but when I grabbed the right arm I was able to pull it behind him. LICHTENBERG then rolled to the right and tried to pull his left arm towards his waist line area. I attempted to grab that arm and just then Off. Mollner arrived at my location. Off. Mollner joined me in yelling for LICHTENBERG to put his other arm behind his back but he continued to pull it towards the waist line area. Off. Mollner yelled "Stop resisting or you'll get maced!" LICHTENBERG continued to struggle and after Off. Mollner yelled the order a second time with no response he sprayed LICHTENBERG in the face with a 2 second burst of ASR.

We were then able to pull LICHTENBERG's left arm behind his back and get him cuffed. We

brought LICHTENBERG back to our SQD. When we got LICHTENBERG back to our SQD we looked on the roof of the garage at 1029 Magnolia and we saw a plastic bag laying in the freshly fallen snow on the north side of the roof. The bag was clearly visible from our standing position in the alley and both Off. Mollner and I ID'd it as the bag we saw LICHTENBERG throw when he ran. It was obvious to us, given the fresh fallen snow the bag could not have been there prior to the incident.

We took the following pictures at the scene:

- 1 - 263-NWX in alley
- 2 - Tab # C2795323
- 3 - 1029 Magnolia - garage
- 4 - Suspected narcotics on roof of garage
- 5 - Same as #4

We called for another SQD to come to the scene and we grabbed a ladder from a neighbor. Off. Mollner used the ladder and recover the plastic bag contained suspected C/S ("Meth") from the roof. We recovered the suspected C/S.

We arranged for the vehicle to be towed. SEE TOW REPORT. We had the tow driver remove the rear plate bearing the wrong tab and we recovered the plate.

We brought LICHTENBERG and the recovered property to HQ. At HQ LICHTENBERG was placed in front of the fan and decontaminated for the ASR exposure.

After LICHTENBERG's eyes were wide open he said he was willing to talk to us. I read LICHTENBERG the rights advisory (recorded) and he agreed to speak with me. Off. Mollner was present also.

LICHTENBERG admitted he knew the tabs on his rear plate did not belong on the car and he said a friend (un-named) had stolen them and put them on his car. He said his father had arranged for him to get new ones. LICHTENBERG said he did not want to talk about the C/S because he did not want to "incriminate" himself. LICHTENBERG said he wanted to talk with someone from the Narcotics Unit and said he was willing to talk with other police officers if needed.

Off. Mollner brought LICHTENBERG up to booking. On the way up Off. Mollner told LICHTENBERG he was going to be searched again at the Annex and he suggested if he had concealed any other narcotics on his person he should tell Off. Mollner. LICHTENBERG said he had no additional narcotics on him. Off. Mollner asked, "So the dope you threw at the scene was all you had?" and LICHTENBERG said, "Yep" and then cringed his face as though he should not have answered.

We booked LICHTENBERG for Possession of C/S and GM Evade State Tax. SEE BOOKING SHEET. RCSD's found no additional narcotics on LICHTENBERG.

We put the film in PL#14. We put the suspected C/S in NL#65 and MN PLT 263-NWX and the audio tape in PL#5. SEE PROPERTY SHEET.

We attached LICHTENBERG's criminal history to the report. LICHTENBERG was on probation with Ramsey County P/O Ying Xiong (PH#651-292-7995).

NARRATIVE

I, Ofcr Heather Weyker, squad #688, am currently assigned to the FORCE Unit. We investigate problem properties and narcotics complaints.

I responded to HQ to interview Jesse Dale Lichtenberg, 12-11-76. He was arrested for Poss of C/S - methamphetamine.

Lichtenberg was read his Miranda Rights per SPPD form PM 247.1-95R. He stated he understood his rights and wished to speak with me regarding his arrest. He signed the form and received a copy of it after the interview was complete. The conversation was taped and turned into property locker # 5.

The following is a summary of our conversation:

Lichtenberg stated he was sitting in the alley way inside his vehicle behind 1029 Magnolia (his residence) and he had an expired registration sticker on the front license plate and an illegally obtained tab on the back license plate and that when he saw the squads and the two officers, he ran. He stated while he was running he had some pre-packaged methamphetamine in his pant pocket and he threw it as he was running. He stated he threw the methamphetamine on top of the garage at 1029 Magnolia.

He stated after he threw it, he stopped and was arrested.

He stated he ran because he knew that having methamphetamine would violate his probation. His probation officer is Ying Xiong, Ramsey County Probation.

He stated he last smoked methamphetamine yesterday (12-03-02).

Lichtenberg was cooperative.

I ended the interview, gave him his copy of his rights, and turned in the tape.

Sqds were dispatched to an agg assault in progress. Upon arrival it was discovered there was no agg assault but a limo was damaged.

NARRATIVE

Sqd 360T, Meyer, Johnson, were dispatched to 1035 E Magnolia for an Agg Assault in progress. The dispatcher said one person had been stabbed and one person had a club of some kind.

Upon our arrival we heard what sounded like people fighting in the alley. We went into the alley and saw a large group of people in the alley holding one person up against the garage. Sqd 319, St. Sauver, Sand, were just arriving as we entered the alley. The people told us the person up against the garage was the one with the knife. Myself and Sand put handcuffs on the person, later verbally id'd as; GANGI, Louis, Joseph, 05/10/1985, 2044 Hyacinth 55119. GANGI was the placed in the back of Sqd 319's car. In the group of people it appeared that only one person was not intoxicated.

I then spoke to the comp, verbally id'd as NYGAARD, Mark, Steven, 01/16/1957, 5084 Long Lake Rd, New Brighton, MN 55112, Home 763-780-4459, Cell 612-297-5144, Work 612-339-8616. NYGAARD told me the following: He was driving his limo when some of his customers wanted to get dropped off. He then went east on the alley north of Magnolia. In the alley there were two people walking. He dropped his customers off behind 1035 E Magnolia. A confrontation began between his customers and and the two in the alley. One was identified as GANGI and the other was described as 6' 3", 170 pounds, short black hair parted at eye level, wearing a plaid shirt possibly blue and white, and wearing blue jeans and possibly had a skull tattoo on his left forearm. GANGI later said it was his friend Michael WRIGHT. WRIGHT originally had a steak knife in his hands. WRIGHT dropped the knife and ran east down the alley. His customers then struggled with GANGI and held him up against a garage on the north side of the alley. WRIGHT then came back into the alley and started to struggle with the customers again. WRIGHT broke free and then broke mirror off of the limo. WRIGHT then ran east down the alley and did not come back.

Officer Sand found the steak knife next to the garage on the north side of the alley behind 1035 Magnolia Av E. I put the knife in crime lab locker # 3 for finger prints.

Sqd 319 cited GANGI for curfew violation and transported him to 2044 Hyacinth and released to his mother.

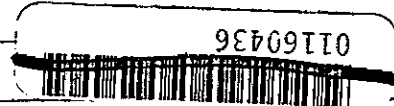
