Noise Source: Minnesota Bicycle Festivals Inc. has requested a sound level variance, in order to present amplified music and announcements on a stage located near the corner of 6th Street West and St. Peter Street, for the Saint Paul Rice Park Criterium on Wednesday, June 11, 2014 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following: 1) Variance will be for the Saint Paul Rice Park Criterium stage located near the corner of 6th Street West and St. Peter Street on June 11, 2014. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA system, loudspeaker or any similar device used in conjunction with the event, will not exceed 85 dBA, as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off by 9:00 p.m. on June 11, 2014. Recommended conditions may change before the date of the public hearing.
