Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on June 28, 2012. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy. This home has been vacant since January 2012. Previous orders to have all work completed under permit and approved by 6/28/12.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Throughout SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-Owner is planning on building a garage under permit.
- 2. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 3. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frames.
- 4. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.

- 5. Interior- Basement SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairway in an approved manner.
- 6. Interior- Throughout SPLC 34.11 (5), 34.34 (2) Contact a licensed contractor to repair or replace the water heater. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Provide a tpr valve in the basement.
- 7. Interior-Throughout SPLC 33.05 Uncertified portions of the building must not be occupied until inspected and approved by this office.-All interior remodel must be done under permit. Owner is remodeling entire vacant home. Will need permits.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
