Your building was inspected on December 9, 2010 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on January 26, 2011 at 1:15pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Stairway MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Replace the broken porcelain light fixture in the basement stairway.
- 2. Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.
- 3. Basement and Main Floor Throughout MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multiplug adapters.

- 4. Detached Garage Fascia and Deck Boards SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Replace the deteriorated/rotted fascia/deckboards on the detached garage.
- 5. Egress Window Upper Floor Bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Upper Floor Bedroom (Double-hung)

20.5h x 23w - Openable 41h x 22w - Glazed

- 6. Exposed Wiring Throughout MSFC 605.1 Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Remove the exposed electrical wiring throughout the property and install according to electrical code. Areas with exposed wiring include throughout the basement, the rear deck, and the north exterior of the house.
- 7. Exterior Chimney SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior chimneys free from holes and deterioration.-Repair/replace the deteriorated/missing chimney brick and tuck-point as needed. All work must be done under permit.
- 8. Rear Deck Stairway SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.-All stairs over 3 risers must have a handrail. Install a handrail on the stairway to the deck.
- 9. Upper Floor Bedroom MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-Remove the double-keyed dead bolt lock from the upper floor bedroom door.
- 10. Window Screens Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-All openable windows must have window screens. Provide and maintain the window screens.
- 11. Windows Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-The sash cords have been removed from the double-hung windows. Repair/replace the windows that are not staying in the open position.
- 12. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

13. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
