Dear Legislative Hearing Officer for the City of Saint Paul:

On Tuesday 29 November 2016, someone unknown to us illegally dumped a soiled twin sized mattress and box spring in the alley in front of my garage at 419 Thomas Avenue in Saint Paul. Unfortunately, we did not catch nor see the culprit, but we know when the dumping occurred because I left my home near 1330hrs to go to the local post office (the alley was clear); when I returned ~1400hrs the alley was clear. At ~1530hrs my wife headed out to work and noticed the bedding in the alley near our garage.

I immediately notified Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspection (DSI) via the Report an Incident form on the DSI website, as I was instructed the last time something like this happened. Meanwhile several motorists traveling through the alley moved and shifted the bedding, including the waste removal providers and propped the box spring against the wall of my garage. We never touched the items.

To my disbelief, I receive in the mail a Summary Abatement Order dated 2 December 2016 from Inspector Ross to remove the mattresses from the alley as if we were responsible for creating the nuisance! I believe this action is punishing the victim or more like shooting the messenger. The mattress set is not ours nor did we put it there, but many hands touched it since 29 November.

I'm concerned that the issuance of the abatement order could be retaliation for a recent correspondence to Mayor Chris Coleman regarding DSI and Public Works delay in removing rubbish (soiled clothes) that was dumped on the side of my garage this past June (attached). Another point worth noting, is the property located directly across the alley from ours at 418 Lafond Avenue belongs to the City of Saint Paul. Finally, the box spring propped against our garage is in the same area that the soiled clothes were dumped in June. Public Works removed those clothes, so what is different that the code inspector did not give the soiled box spring/mattress equal treatment and request Public Works to remove them? We dare not risk the potential health hazards by even getting near these items, not to mention actually touching them.

We did nothing wrong. Why should we be punished for someone else's crime? We ask that the abatemen't order be dismissed and St Paul Public Works pick up the box spring and mattress in the alley near our garage.

As owner or person(s) responisble for: 419 THOMAS AVE you are hereby ordered to eliminate all nuisance conditions which are in violation of Chapter 45 of Saint Paul Legislative Code.

1. Remove improperly stored or accumulated refuse including: garbage, rubbish, loose and scattered litter, discarded furniture, appliances, vehicle parts, scrap wood and metal, recycling materials, household items, building materials or rubble, tires, brush, etc., from property, boulevard, alley and yard areas INCLUDING PLEASE REMOVE THE MATTRESSES IN THE ALLEY. THANKS! Comply before December 8, 2016

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal **before December 08, 2016**, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

<u>Charges</u>: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipments, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260 per hour plus expensed for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN A CRIMINAL CITATION

<u>APPEALS:</u> You may appeal this order and obtain a hearing before the City Council by completing an appeal application with the City Clerk before the appeal deadline noted above or seven (7) days after the date mailed, which ever comes first. The telephone number is (651) 266-8688. You must submit a copy of this Summary Abatement Notice with your appeal application.

*WARNING Code inspection and enforcement trips cost the taxpayers money. If the violations are not corrected within the time period required in this notice, the city's costs in conducting a reinspection after the due date for compliance will be collected from the owner rather than being paid by the taxpayers of the city. Dear Mayor Coleman,

I'd like to bring to your attention an issue we have with the city's failure to clean up an illegal rubbish dumping in the alley against our garage at 419 Thomas Avenue. On 23 June 2016 between 11:30 am and 6:50 pm an unscrupulous party dumped a broken bag of soiled clothing and a microwave against my garage. I immediately called St. Paul police department to report it and was transferred to St. Paul Public Works who in turn told me to report the incident to Saint Paul Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) who will in turn write up a work order. I sent an email to DSI and followed up with DSI on the phone the next day. A DSI staff said that she will dispatch an inspector to investigate. That is the last I've heard of DSI or Public Works.

We went on vacation in Canada from 24 June to 7 July. You can imagine the dismay upon our return to find the rubbish still against our garage. And it appears more items were added to our alley (see photos taken on 7 July). I'm wondering why these items were not picked up?

Unfortunately, this is not an isolated incident, for rubbish is often dumped in our alley almost every month of the year.
