**Requested Board Action** 

Adoption of the attached HRA Resolution to approve the 2018 final HRA budget and certify the

maximum HRA Tax Levy payable in 2018.

Background

To comply with the State of Minnesota's Truth-In-Taxation laws, the HRA must certify to

Ramsey County, by December 31, 2017, the final HRA property tax levy payable in 2018. The

attached Resolution, if approved, will certify this proposed levy by that date.

The projected 2018 maximum HRA levy allowed under State Law is \$4,086,915 which is

\$540,318 more than the final 2017 certified HRA tax levy payable by Saint Paul taxpayers in

2017. The proposed 2018 HRA tax levy is \$3,822,159 which is \$275,562 more than the final

2017 HRA certified tax levy. The actual final levy must be certified by December 31, 2017, and

cannot be higher than the proposed levy.

The HRA property tax levy provides revenue to the HRA General Fund. Activities financed by

the HRA General Fund budget include maintenance of HRA properties, City maintenance and

public improvement assessments on HRA property, administration of HRA programs,

acquisition of tax forfeited properties, City Attorney services for the HRA, mandated State audit

of the HRA, court costs related to litigation, and operating support for the Department of

Planning and Economic Development which provides staffing to the HRA.
