Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on June 28, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on July 26, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement lower unit stairs SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 2. Basement upper unit panel NEC 230-2 (e) Provide identification at the service disconnect for each electrical circuit.-Label the circuits in the panel box.

- 3. Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Vent missing, open hole. Overhead door not secure.
- 4. Garage SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairway in an approved manner.-Provide a code compliant step for the interior of the garage at the side door.

Upper unit - Multiple locations - MSFC 605.5 - Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.

Windows - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-

Upper Unit Front: Double hung, 28h x 16.5w

• Upper Unit Rear: Remove the A/C unit from the egress window

Lower Unit Front: Size meets requirements, but goes into an enclosed porch.

SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
