Thank you for meeting with me today to do a walk-through of the property at 201 4th St E. There are a considerable number of deficiencies throughout the building, both inside and out. However, there are items that, in my opinion, must be addressed in haste:

- 1.) Investigate and confirm that the suppression system is active and fully functional reflective of the current codes
- 2.) Investigate and confirm that the alarm system is active and fully functional reflective of the current codes
- 3.) Investigate and confirm, by a registered designer of the state of Minnesota, the basement steel/masonry/clay tile ceiling and rear foundation
- 4.) Investigate and confirm, by a licensed roofing contractor, that the roofing system requires complete removal/replacement

I would suggest we offer thirty (30) days to the owner to complete these requirements and have the reports submitted for review. The results of these reports would give direction on how to proceed with these issues. Additionally, I would also stipulate a specific timeline to correct the other deficiencies throughout the building. Interior and exterior corrections appear to be needed under appropriate permits from our office for inpsections.




