Your building was inspected on February 11, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on March 10, 2011 at 9:30 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Child Bedroom - MSFC 1011.2 - Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove bed from in front of bedroom window.

Child Bedroom - NEC 110-26 - Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.-Maintain unobstructed path to fuse box. Materials cannot be on top of basement trap door.

- 3. Living Room and Upper Bedroom - MSFC 605.5 - Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-If needed, replace with power strips.
- 4. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 5. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
