Noise Source: Forward Events, LLC has applied for a sound level variance, with a sound level request of 85- 90 dBA at no specified distance, in order to provide music outdoors at Mears Park for the St Paul Food Truck Festival on Saturday, September 24, 2016, from 11:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 10:45 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for Saturday, September 24, 2016 and the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 10:45 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 9:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
