On behalf of the St. Paul Area Association of REALTORS® (SPAAR) and its Board of Directors, please accept this letter as our official response to the proposed ordinance to allow for Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) city-wide.

Based on a unanimous vote of the SPAAR's Government Affairs Committee on July 31, 2018, SPAAR is pleased to support the proposed amendments to Chapters 65 and 66 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code to allow for ADUs city-wide.
