Your building was inspected on November 22, 2016 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on December 22, 2016 at 11:00A.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Garage - SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) - All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-

- 2. Next to garage SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.-
- SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this
 office.
- 4. MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-
- 5. MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-
- 6. SPLC 200.02 (a) No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989-
- 7. MSFC 1029.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. Such opening shall open directly into a public way, public alley, or a yard or court that opens to a public way. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Bedroom on the south side of house opens onto a locked porch.
