Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on July 11, 2012 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on or after July 20, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Interior - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-Condemned due to lack of basic facilities (electricity). Immediately restore service or vacate the building.
2. SPLC 45.03 (6) - Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall on South side of building.
3. SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) - All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
4. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Provide or repair and maintain the window screens throughout the building.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
