The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny the license.

Our review of your application for a license is in process with Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI). Notification has been sent to the community organization for the area in which you intend to operate giving them until Friday, July 14, 2017 to voice any objections to your license application. If no objections are received, your license will be issued (pending any requirements not completely met) approximately one week past the date given above.

If objections are received, a hearing will be scheduled before a legislative hearing officer and you will receive notice of the time, place and date of the hearing. At that hearing, the hearing officer will take testimony from all interested parties and make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the license should be approved or be referred to an administrative law judge for further review. The City Council has the final authority to grant or deny this license application.

Requirements including the following must be met prior to the issuance of your license:

- Sign and return one copy of the enclosed license condition affidavit acknowledging the conditions that will be placed on your license(s). A return envelope has been included for your convenience.
- Obtain all necessary building and/or trade permits related to any construction work associated with the establishment of this use, and all required inspection approval(s) related to these permit(s). Only licensed trade contractors authorized to perform work in that trade (e.g., plumbing, electrical, ventilation, etc.) may obtain permit(s) and/or perform work in such trade.
- Submit a written statement explaining what actions you will take to minimize noise or disturbance on the building residents.
- Obtain DSI Environmental Health approval of your construction plans and inspection approval for the buildout once the plans have been approved. You may contact Barb McMonigal-St. Dennis, DSI Environmental Health Inspector, at 651-266-9137 to arrange for the plan review and inspection approval.
