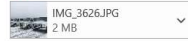

Hi Sean,

4 Ford vans (15 passengers) were picked up from Sparta yesterday and are at the training center in Rochester. You are welcome to come down and pick the 2 that you would like for MFD. The remaining 2 vans will be offered first to any MNTF1 agency and then to any MN Fire Department. If you think you'd be interested in more than 2, that's fine also. 3 of the vans were driven back from Sparta as is. The 4th was trailered only because we were short a driver. All seem to be serviceable. All units were manufactured in 2009. Mileages are 35K, 41K, 49K, and 51K. There is no cost associated with the vans. There is a simple form/process for obtaining the title(s). After 2 years you are free to do whatever you want with the vehicle (sell, scrap, trade, etc.). If prior to the 2 years there is a reason you want to get rid of the vehicle (i.e. significant mechanical issue not worth fixing) there is a process, it just involves a bit of documentation. Please let me know what works for you coming to Rochester and I will get it scheduled on our end.
