

**NEIGHBORHOOD PETITION TO THE SAINT PAUL MN CITY COUNCIL REGARDING THE SHEPARD ROAD (USBANK SITE) PROJECT**

Neighbors are in favor of a development at the USBank Site—one that beautifies and enhances the values of the neighborhood; however, neighbors have two major objections to the proposed development plans:

- Neighbors oppose a variance to the height restriction on the River Corridor: construction should stay within the maximum 40-foot above-ground rule.
- Neighbors strongly oppose the re-routing of Shepard Road to Norfolk/Stewart Avenues and making it a 5-lane exit off of Hwy 5.


