NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Abdinoor Dolal:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend adverse action against the Taxicab Vehicle licenses for Cab #781, Cab #783, Cab #1386 and Cab #1974 held by Twin Cities Airport Taxi & Limo Svc., Inc. d/b/a Twin Cities Airport Taxi & Limo Service for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

On February 27, 2013, the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) received a Certificate of Liability Insurance from National Casualty Co. showing liability insurance coverage for Cab #781, Cab #1386 and Cab #1974 from November 16, 2012 through November 16, 2013. Your previous policy with American Casualty Company showed coverage from November 11, 2011 through November 11, 2012. This shows a lapse in insurance coverage from November 11, 2012 to November 16, 2012.

Also, according to the Certificate of Liability Insurance, Cab #783 was not added to the current policy until January 29, 2013. This shows a lapse in insurance coverage from November 11, 2012 through January 29, 2013.

Due to the fact that these insurance violations involved four (4) of your taxicabs, per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office will recommend a \$500.00 matrix penalty for each lapse in insurance for a total of \$2,000.00.

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At this time, you have two options on how to proceed:

- 1. You can pay the recommended \$2,000.00 matrix penalty. If this is your choice, you should make payment directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday**, **April 22**, **2013**. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Payment of the \$2,000.00 matrix penalty will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by **Monday, April 22, 2013.** The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to impose the \$2,000.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 3. If you <u>dispute the facts</u> outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). You will need to send me a letter disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing no later than **Monday, April 22, 2013**. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

Please note: If you choose an administrative hearing, the Department of Safety and Inspections reserves the right to request that City Council impose the costs of the administrative hearing per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (k).

If you have not contacted me or DSI by Monday, April 22, 2013, I will assume that you do not contest the imposition of the \$2,000.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
