### NOTICE OF INTENT TO DENY LICENSES

Dear Momtaz Mahayni :

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend denial of the Food Vending Machine, Food Vending Machine Operator and Food Vehicle license applications submitted by Momtaz Mahayni d/b/a A And M M Corp for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

**On June 12, 2012, you were sent a letter from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) stating that your license applications have been "Pending" since July 26, 2011 and would remain pending until you obtained a DSI Environmental Health Inspection Approval.**

**During a phone conversation with DSI Inspector Jeff Fischbach on June 11, 2012, you were asked to contact Abdi Museid at (651) 266-9141 to schedule an Environmental Facility Inspection of your proposed business operation. In addition, according to DSI records, you also need to schedule an Environmental Vehicle Inspection and submit the vehicle license number required if transporting food, goods, etc...**

**You were then given until June 29, 2012, to schedule the Environmental Facility Inspection. As of today's date, neither the facility or vehicle inspections have been scheduled and the vehicle license number has not been submitted.**

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

1. You can call Abdi Museid, DSI Environmental Health Inspector at (651)266-9141 to schedule an Environmental Facility Inspection no later than **Monday, July 23, 2012**.
2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter no later than **Monday, July 23, 2012**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to deny your licenses. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

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3. You can withdraw your license applications. Send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections at 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, July 23, 2012**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. Any request for a refund of the license application fees must also be made in writing to the Department of Safety and Inspections.

**If you have not contacted me or DSI by Monday, July 23, 2012, I will assume that you do not contest the denial of your licenses. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.**
