Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on October 4, 2010. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on November 9, 2010 at 11:15 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. EXTERIOR 904-906 SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Repair latch on rear storm door.
- 2. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
- 3. INTERIOR 906 SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.

- 4. INTERIOR 904 UNIT 2 MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Upon inspection, 904 Unit 2: window in south bedroom measured 18.5 inches openable height x 29 inches openable width; window in east bedroom measured 18.5 inches openable height x 23 inches openable width. Window in 904 Unit 1 measured 18.5 inches openable height x 24 inches openable width.
- 5. INTERIOR 904 Unit 2 SPLC 34.11 (6) Provide and maintain a minimum of 68 degrees F in all habitable rooms at all times.-Repair non-working baseboard heater in a professional manner.
- 6. INTERIOR ALL UNITS MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 7. INTERIOR ALL UNITS MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-Immediately replace batteries in all chirping smoke detectors.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
