NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance Mississippi River Blvd and Old Ford Plant Team Ortho Foundation Monster Dash 2017

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: Mississippi River Blvd and the Old Ford Plant Entrance

Noise Source: Team Ortho Foundation has requested a sound level variance to provide the use of a sound system for announcements and amplified outdoor sound for the Monster Dash Event. The variance is requested for the hours of 9:00 a.m. until 10:45 a.m., with a pre-event sound check at 8:45 a.m. on Mississippi River Blvd and the Old Ford Plant on Saturday, October 28, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 10:45 a.m., with a pre-event sound check at 8:45 a.m. for Mississippi River Blvd and the Old Ford Plant on Saturday, October 28, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:45 a.m. on the date of the event.
