Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on July 18, 2024, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

The property shall be vacated on August 5, 2024

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke alarm affidavit and return it to this office.
2. Sec. 40.06. - Suspension, revocation and denial.(a)Grounds for revocation. The fire code official may, in writing, issue a notice to the owner(s) and known interested parties of the city's suspension or revocation of a fire certificate of occupancy issued under the provisions of this code, or deny an application therefor;(3)If it is found upon inspection of the fire code official that the building or occupancy is in violation of provisions of this or other applicable safety codes, ordinances, rules and regulations; **Pending revocation due to but not limited to long term non-compliance. Unable to gain access for certificate of occupancy inspections. Attempted inspections on 4-17-2024, 5-16-2024, 6-18-2024, 7-16-2024 and 7-18-2024.**

3. SPLC 34.19 - Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
