Your building was inspected on August 13, 2018 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

## A re-inspection will be made on September 24, 2018 at 1:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Front Stairs SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-The front stairs are in disrepair.
- 2. Exterior Garage SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. -There are very large cracks on the garage walls and the garage door trim has chipping and peeling paint.

- 3. Exterior Garage SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.32 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces. -There is garbage in the garage. Remove the garbage and maintain clean.
- 4. Exterior Garage SPLC 34.08 (10) Repair, replace and maintain exterior sidewalks, walkways and stairs. -Patch up the sidewalk in front of the garage.
- 5. Exterior House SPLC 34.09 (1)(2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. -All around the house there is chipping and peeling paint and damages to the soffits, fascia and the gutters. Especially there is a section of the fascia that is sticking out.
- 6. Exterior Roof SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
- 7. Exterior Interior Windows SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.

  Exterior The top window at the front of the house is in disrepair.

  Interior There are several windows that have chipping and peeling paint, are unable to stay open, have broken sash cords and unable to latch.
- 8. Interior Basement MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 9. Interior Basement NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as: room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.
- 10. Interior Door SPLC 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition. -The door leading to the upper level does not fit properly within its frame and is unable to close.
- 11. Interior Kitchen SPLC 34.14 (2) c Repair or replace the duplex convenience outlet with ground fault protection within 3 feet of the basin on an adjacent wall in all bathrooms. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-One of the GFCI outlet in the kitchen is loose within the wall and is unsecure.
- 12. Interior Kitchen SPLC 34.10 (7) Repair and maintain the cabinets in an approved manner. -One of the cabinets is missing the handle.

13. SPLC 200.02 (a) - No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989-There is one dog and seven (7) cats in the house.
