### NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND LICENSE

Dear Mr. Haugen:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended suspension of the House Sewer Contractor license held by Kober Excavating, Inc. d/b/a Kober Excavating for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

**On August 5, 2010, you were sent a SECOND REQUEST from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) asking that you submit a current original License and Permit Bond in the amount of \$10,000.00 for the coverage dates of March 28, 2010 to March 28, 2011.**

**You were given until August 19, 2010 to submit the required bond information. As of today's date it has not been received.**

In addition to the suspension of your House Sewer Contractor license, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office will also recommend a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit the required bond information in order to maintain your license.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:


1. You can submit the required bond information. If this is your choice, you should send it directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, October 25, 2010**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Submission of the requested bond information will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.

2. If you wish to admit the facts but contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council, you will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting the facts and requesting a public hearing. We will need to receive your letter by **Monday, October 25, 2010**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to suspend your license and impose the \$500.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
  
3. If you no longer wish to do business in the City of Saint Paul, you will need to send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, October 25, 2010**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek.

**If you have not contacted me by that date, I will assume that you do not contest the suspension of your license and imposition of the \$500.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.**


