Hello, I have a few proposals for the Ford Site design standards, particularly landscape and building standards. They are as follows:

- G1 - Encourage native and pollinator-friendly plants for private lawns and gardens
- G2 - Encourage permeable pavement to enhance stormwater management
- G15 - Recommend maximum window area percentage for total facade of 30%. This supports energy efficiency and climate resilience in new buildings.
