NOTICE OF INTENT TO DENY LICENSE

Dear Applicant:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend denial of the Pedal Car Driver license application submitted by Aaron J. Mandelman for the City of Saint Paul. The recommendation is based on the following information:

On March 1, 2018, you were sent a letter from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) stating that the Pedal Car Driver license application you submitted had been "pending" since July 27, 2017. In order to complete the application process, you were asked to provide an official copy of your Wisconsin state driving record for the previous three (3) years.

You were given until March 27, 2018 to provide the required State of Wisconsin driving record. As of today's date, that information has not been provided to the Department of Safety and Inspections.

At this time, you have four (4) options on how to proceed:

1. If I have not heard from you by **Friday**, **April 13**, **2018**, I will presume that you have chosen not to contest the proposed adverse action, and the matter will be placed on the next available City Council Agenda for approval of the proposed remedy.

- 2. Submit an official copy of your Wisconsin state driving records for the previous three (3) years to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) located at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Friday, April 13, 2018.** A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Submission of the required State of Wisconsin driving record will be considered a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 3. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing no later than **Friday**, **April 13**, **2018.** The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council to determine whether to deny your Pedal Car Driver license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the City Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 4. You can withdraw your Pedal Car Driver license application. Please complete and return the attached <u>REQUEST TO WITHDRAW REQUEST FOR REFUND</u> form to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI), located at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Friday**, **April 13**, **2018**.

If you have not contacted me by Friday, April 13, 2018, I will assume that you do not contest the denial of your Pedal Car Driver license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the next available City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
