<u>REVISED</u> PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE – CITY COUNCIL APPEAL <u>*NEW HEARING DATE*</u>

Purpose:	An appeal of a decision by the Board of Zoning Appeals denying two variance requests to establish a supportive housing facility. The zoning code states that supportive housing facilities shall be a minimum distance of 1,320 feet from specified congregate living facilities with more than six (6) adult residents; this facility is 1,044 feet from another congregate living facility with more than six (6) adult residents, for a zoning variance of 276 feet. 2.) In the B2 zoning district, the facility must serve sixteen (16) or fewer facility residents; 22 are proposed, for a variance of 6 residents.
