Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on March 23, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on or after March 31, 2011.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Bedroom South West Side - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-This is and awning window. The measurements are 13 inches openable height. This is a push out window. The Glazed area is 24 inches in height by 54 inches in width. Sill height is 58 inches. This window was not called at the first inspection because the tenant was to trade bedrooms per the landlord and tenant agreement. This did not happen so the tenant is still in the same bedroom. owner states he will file another appeal for the awning windows.
