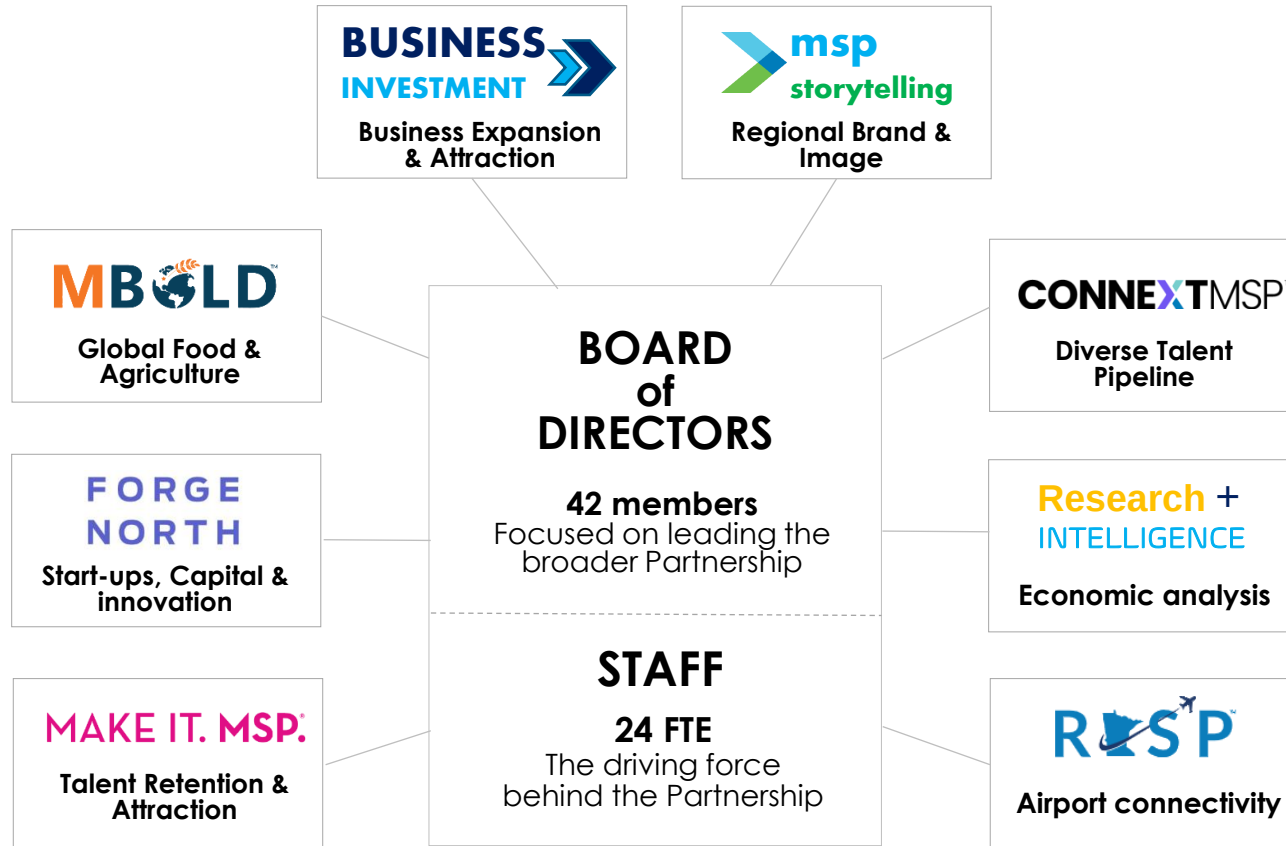

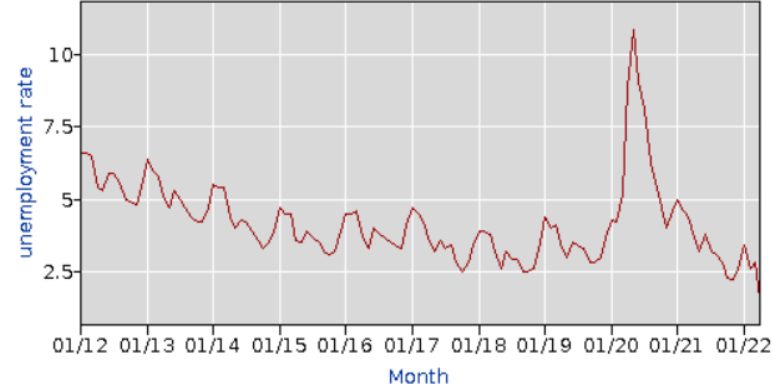

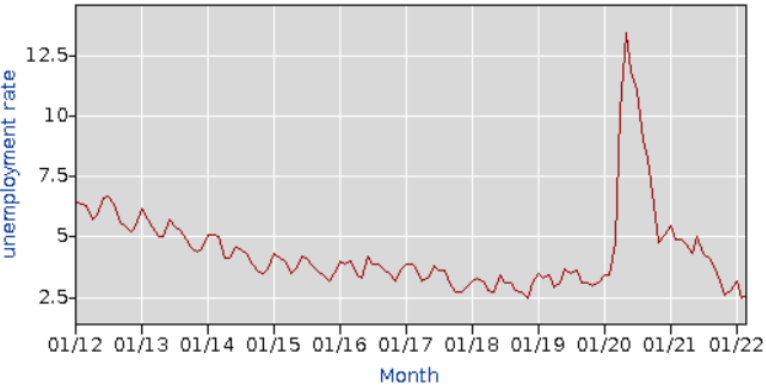

Where in the economy are jobs being created?



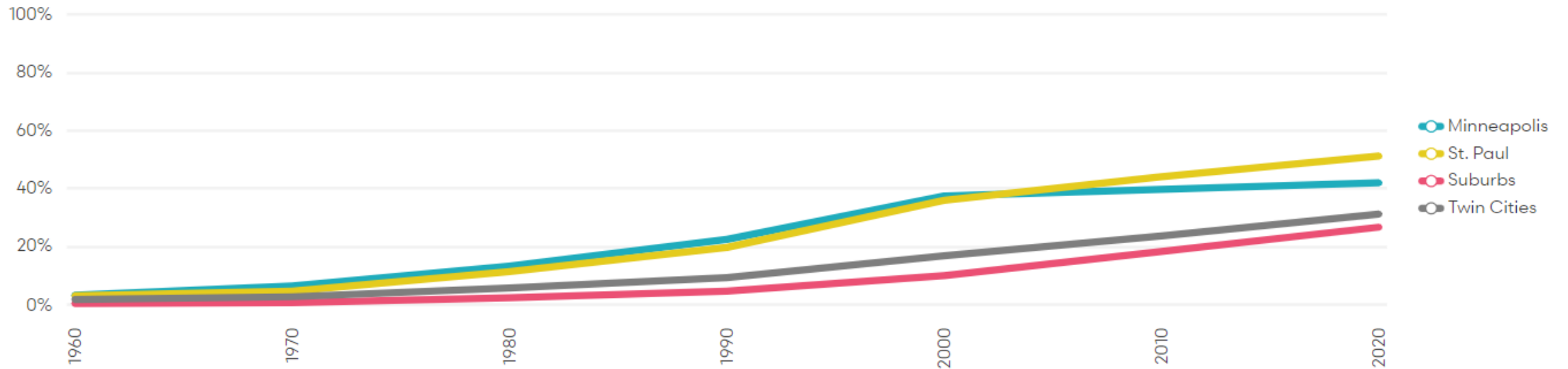

Central cities and suburbs, Twin Cities 7-county region, 1950-2020



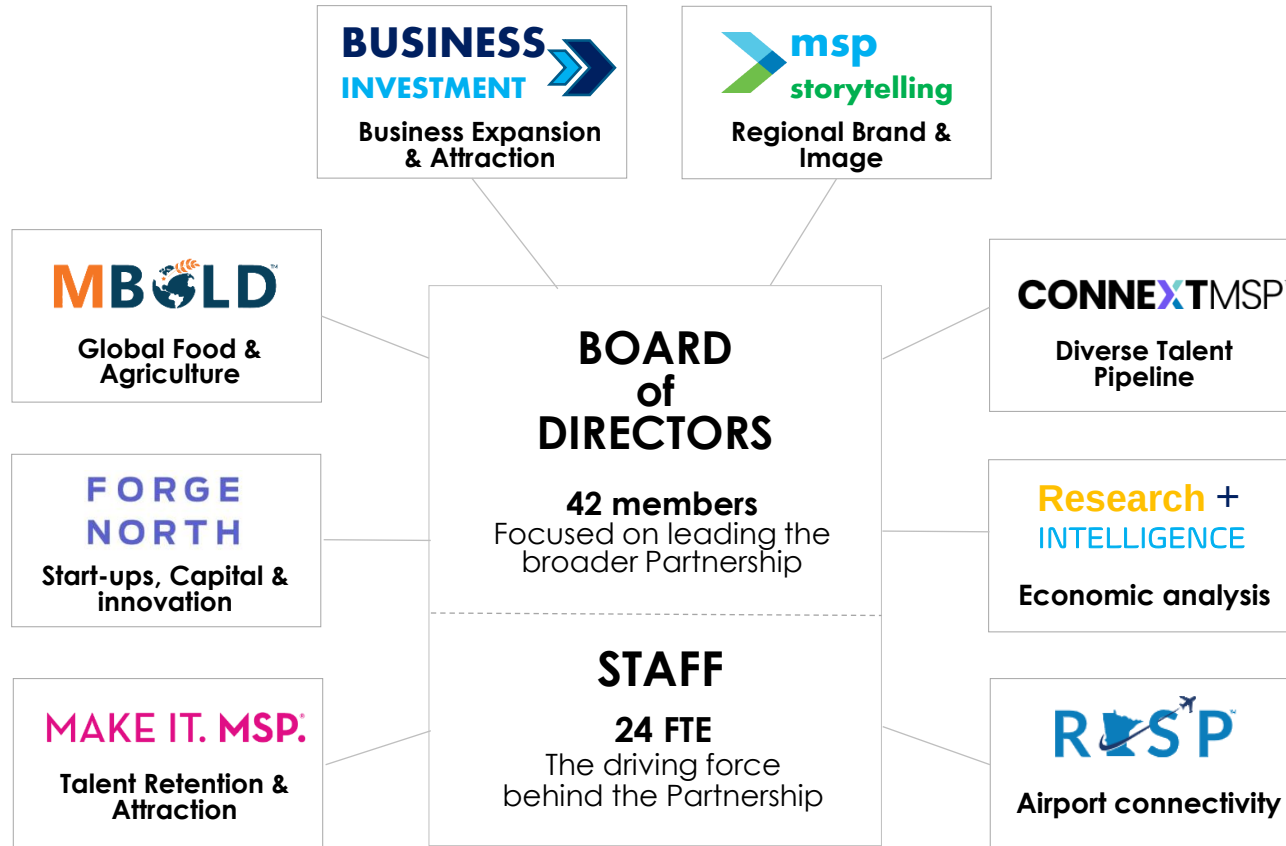

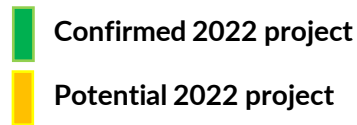
