Synopsis:

On 05.27.2024 at approximately 0447 hours, Officers were dispatched to the area of 276 Exchange Street South for a report of hearing glass break. Officers located a broken window of the residence and located five juveniles inside the residence. The address was on the vacant list and juveniles were turned over to parents. See report for more information.

Narrative:

On 05.27.2024 at approximately 0447 hours, I, Officer Heuer and Officer Z. Moore (210) were dispatched to the area of 276 Exchange Street S St Paul MINNESOTA 55102 (Fore Paughs restaurant) for a report of hearing glass break around 430am and is believed to be coming from this address due to the place being under construction.

When we arrived on scene, I noticed a flashlight from inside near the main entrance and I then located a broken glass window on the Southeast corner. I requested more squads to respond at this time, I announced myself as St. Paul Police and gave commands to come out. I heard a voice state they were coming out and five juveniles came out from the broken window. I gave commands to all the juveniles to get on the ground on the porch where they were taken into custody without incident.

Dispatch aired to officers that the house was on the vacant list and there were signs posted on the front door "No trespassing". Other squads arrived on scene and cleared the building without locating anyone else inside.

| The one party I had detained was placed in the rear of my squad and was verbally identified as was read his Miranda rights due to him being in handcuffs and he stated he was staying at his cousin's house with another friend when they got picked up by a female named who was also detained. Stated they arrived in a black Honda pilot around 430am and had heard about this place online about it being haunted. Stated the window was broken prior to them arriving and none of them broke the window. Stated they were inside for a short period of time and then were going to leave but saw the officers arrive on scene. Stated they got scared when they saw officers and then came out when the officers told them to come out. |

Martell (224) was dispatched to 276 Exchange St S to a report of the complainant hearing the sound of glass break at approximately 0430 hours followed by 3 hammer blows and pry noises. The complainant believed it was coming from the area around Forepaugh's Restaurant (276 Exchange St S). While I was enroute to the call, I heard Sqd. 210 (Ofcs. T. Heuer / Z. business and there was a broken window on the southeast corner. I arrived on scene and assisted Officer Heuer with calling 5 juveniles out of the broken window. All 5 juveniles were ordered to prone out on the platform just outside the broken window. All the juveniles were compliant and were detained in handcuffs.

I took one of the juveniles and put him in my squad car (2366). I identified him as stated that him and his 4 friends had learned that Forepaugh's Restaurant is supposed to be haunted. They all met up in Cottage Grove, MN before driving to the restaurant in a single vehicle. All 5 juveniles are from Cottage Grove. Stated the window was already broken when they got to the restaurant. He stated the 5 of them entered the building and were exploring inside when officers arrived on scene and called them out.

There were rocks just inside the broken window along with wet footprints from the juveniles. With the findings on scene along with the report of the complainant, it is believed that one of the juveniles broke the window. However, they all deny breaking it.

On 05/27/2024 at approximately 0447 hours Officer Heuer and I, Officer Z. Moore (Squad 210) responded to the area of Irvine Park for the report of a suspicious call where the caller woke up to the sound of glass breaking and someone prying on something.

The caller, Mccormick, Keith Allen (DOB/1948-08-06, C/P: 651-224-0678, Address/ 30 Irvine Park) woke up around 0430-0445 hours to the sound of the breaking glass. The caller did not see anything but only could hear the sounds. The caller also stated that the sound of breaking glass sounded as if it was coming from "Forepaughs" (276 Exchange Street S). MCCORMICK was contacted after the call to see if there was any additional information. MCCORMICK stated that he did not have any additional information and did not see anything but only heard the sounds and thought that it was too early for construction crews to be working.

As we were driving into the area I could see a flashlight inside of the front door of the address. The address looked as if it was under renovation and as if no one was living at the address. Officer began walking around the address and Officer Heuer located a broken window on the southeast corner of the address. Five juveniles that were "Urban Exploring" at the address were called out and taken into custody. See his report for more information.

No one came out of the door, but I remained on the west side of the address holding the door. Officers eventually entered and cleared the address from any other occupants. No one else was located. It also should be noted that there were no damages to the inside of the address located by police other than the exterior window on the southeast corner.

I contacted Ramsey County Dispatch to have them send out a board up crew to have the window that was broken covered.




