Dear Commissioners:

I am writing to oppose Charter Commission Item 19-6 amending Section 8.03: Determination of Sufficiency. The proposed language mandates the city clerk to reject a petition signature when the provided name, address and birth year do not match the voter's corresponding record on the public list of registered voters.

Referendum petitions are inherently opposed to a council's action. The proposed Section 8.03 language gives the council-appointed city clerk substantial discretion to decide whether the petition information "matches" the voter record. Signatures could be rejected for any discrepancy with the voter list (see examples in Attachment A).

Signing a petition is neither a vote nor a legislative act. I recommend that "eligible voter" replace "registered voter" for a valid signature under Section 8.02. The city clerk need only verify that the petition address is within St. Paul. This validation process eliminates subjective determinations about whether a signature "matches" the voter record and is readily transparent to the petitioners.

ATTACHMENT A: Examples of invalidated signatures not "matching" the voter record

Ramsey County Elections Office invalidated these signatures on my 2017 charter-amendment petition because the "Signer [is] not registered to vote in Saint Paul as indicated on petition." I have provided the signer's contemporaneous public voter record data above the signature line for comparison.

ATTACHMENT B: "Registered voter" and "registered to vote" are not equivalent

City of St. Paul Charter Section 8.02 requires petition signers to be registered voters, not registered to vote. A registered voter who moves, changes name or becomes inactive remains a registered voter but must <u>update</u> his or her registration before voting again. The person is not required to re-register.

2018 Minnesota Statutes

201.021 PERMANENT REGISTRATION SYSTEM.

A permanent system of voter registration by county is established, with a single, official, centralized, interactive computerized statewide voter registration list defined, maintained, and administered at the state level that contains the name and registration information of every legally registered voter in the state, and assigns a unique identifier to each legally registered voter in the state. The interactive computerized statewide voter registration list constitutes the official list of every legally registered voter in the state. The county auditor shall be chief registrar of voters and the chief custodian of the official registration records in each county. The secretary of state is responsible for defining, maintaining, and administering the centralized system.
