CORRECTION NOTICE - COMPLAINT INSPECTION

1492 CLARENCE ST RE:

Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on October 9, 2012 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately. A re-inspection will be made on November 6, 2012 at 11:30AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- ANNUAL FURNACE MAINTENANCE PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 1. (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 2. BASEMENT DAYCARE AREA - EGRESS WINDOW REQUIREMENTS - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Ensure that the west windows of the basement daycare area are openable and meet the minimum openable dimensions for egress windows.
- BASEMENT DAYCARE AREA PROVIDE LADDER FOR EGRESS WINDOW SPLC 34.13 (4) -3. Provide and maintain a minimum egress window sill height of 48 inches. Refer to provide handout EW-1 for more information.-Provide a permanently affixed ladder or steps for the egress windows in the basement daycare area.

- 4. BASEMENT DRYER PROVIDE REQUIRED EXHAUST DUCT UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-May have up to a 6 foot transition of flexible metal exhaust duct.
- 5. EMERGENCY PLANS PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION MSFC 404.2 Provide an approved fire and emergency evacuation plan.
- 6. GARAGE DOOR PROVIDE SELF CLOSER MSFC 705.1 Provide a required occupancy separation with approved materials and methods.-Provide door self closer to the door between the garage and interior house.
- 7. KITCHEN PROVIDE FIRE EXTINGUISHER MSFC 906.1, MN Stat. 299F.361 --Provide minimum 2A10BC fire extinguishers for the kitchen. It must be permanently mounted between 3 and 5 feet high in readily visible and easily accessible locations.
- 8. MAIN ENTERANCE HANDRAIL FOR LOWER STEPS SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.-Provide handrail for the lower level steps to the main entrance.
- 9. NEAR SLEEPING ROOM PROVIDE CO2 ALARM MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 10. *THREE BEDROOM EGRESS WINDOWS OPENABLE DIMENSIONS MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be
 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable
 width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI
 at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more
 information.-Three bedrooms of the main level all have egress windows with the openable
 dimensions of 30 inches wide by 15 inches high.
