Locations for DC 17: CHS Field; Lower Landing Park; Shepard Road and Sibley; Cathedral Hill Park and Summit near Nina to Selby

Noise Source: Team Ortho Foundation has requested sound level variances to provide the use of a sound system for announcements and amplified outdoor music for the Monster Dash Event. The variances are requested for various times between the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 1:30 p.m., with pre-event sound checks between 7:45 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. in District Council 17 at CHS Field; Lower Landing Park; Shepard Road and Sibley; Cathedral Hill Park and Summit near Nina to Selby on Saturday, October 28, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variances shall be for various times between the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 1:30 p.m., with pre-event sound checks between 7:45 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. at the following District Council 17 locations: CHS Field; Lower Landing Park; Shepard Road and Sibley; Cathedral Hill Park and Summit near Nina to Selby on Saturday, October 28, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured at 50 feet at the CHS Field site; 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet at the Lower Landing Park site, and shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. at Shepard Road and Sibley, and at Summit near Nina to Selby and Cathedral Hill Park. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 1:30 p.m. on the date of the event.

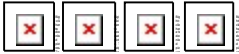
