Noise Source: The Metropolitan Council has requested a sound level variance to allow construction activity associated with the Central Corridor Light Rail construction work from December 6, 2012 to December 31, 2012 on Cedar Street between 7<sup>th</sup> Street and 11<sup>th</sup> Street for an unlimited number of double shifts (6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.) and up to 15 overnight shifts (10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.).
