Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Unit 6- Bathroom MSFC 604.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. Electrical wiring, devices, appliances and other equipment that is modified or damaged and constitutes an electrical shock or fire hazard shall not be used. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Bathroom light switch pops/crackles when turned on or off and light flickers.
- 2. Unit 6 Living Room Window SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame. -Living room window frame is rotted out. Repair or replace frame.

- 3. Unit 6 Throughout SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.34 (5) Every owner of a structure shall be responsible for the control and/or elimination of insects, rodents or other pests wherever infestation exists. -Bed bug infestation and rodents observed in unit. Please provide documentation of pest control efforts.
- Unit 6- Kitchen Bathroom SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1
   Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition. -Water leaking in Kitchen and bathroom sinks.
