SNOW Emergency Information

The City of Saint Paul declares a Snow Emergency after significant snowfall and before 3 p.m. on any given day. When an emergency is declared, residents are asked to follow specific parking guidelines to allow for efficient snow removal operations. Vehicles in violation of parking restrictions will be ticketed and towed.

- Night Plow Routes include all downtown streets and streets with signs posted that say "Night Plow Route" and "Night Plow Route - This Side of Street."
- Day Plow Routes are **not** posted with Night Plow Route signs. If the street is not downtown or marked as a Night Plow Route, it is considered a Day Plow Route.

Night Plowing

Begins at 9 P.M. the Evening a Snow Emergency is Declared



Night Parking

- REMEMBER: See the sign, move it by 9!**
- Parking is **NOT ALLOWED** on Night Plow Routes until the street is plowed full width.
 - Parking **IS ALLOWED** on streets without a Night Plow Route sign.
- Night Plow Routes are typically completed by 8 a.m. the day after the emergency has been declared.

Day Plowing

Day Plow Routes are plowed after Night Plow Routes.

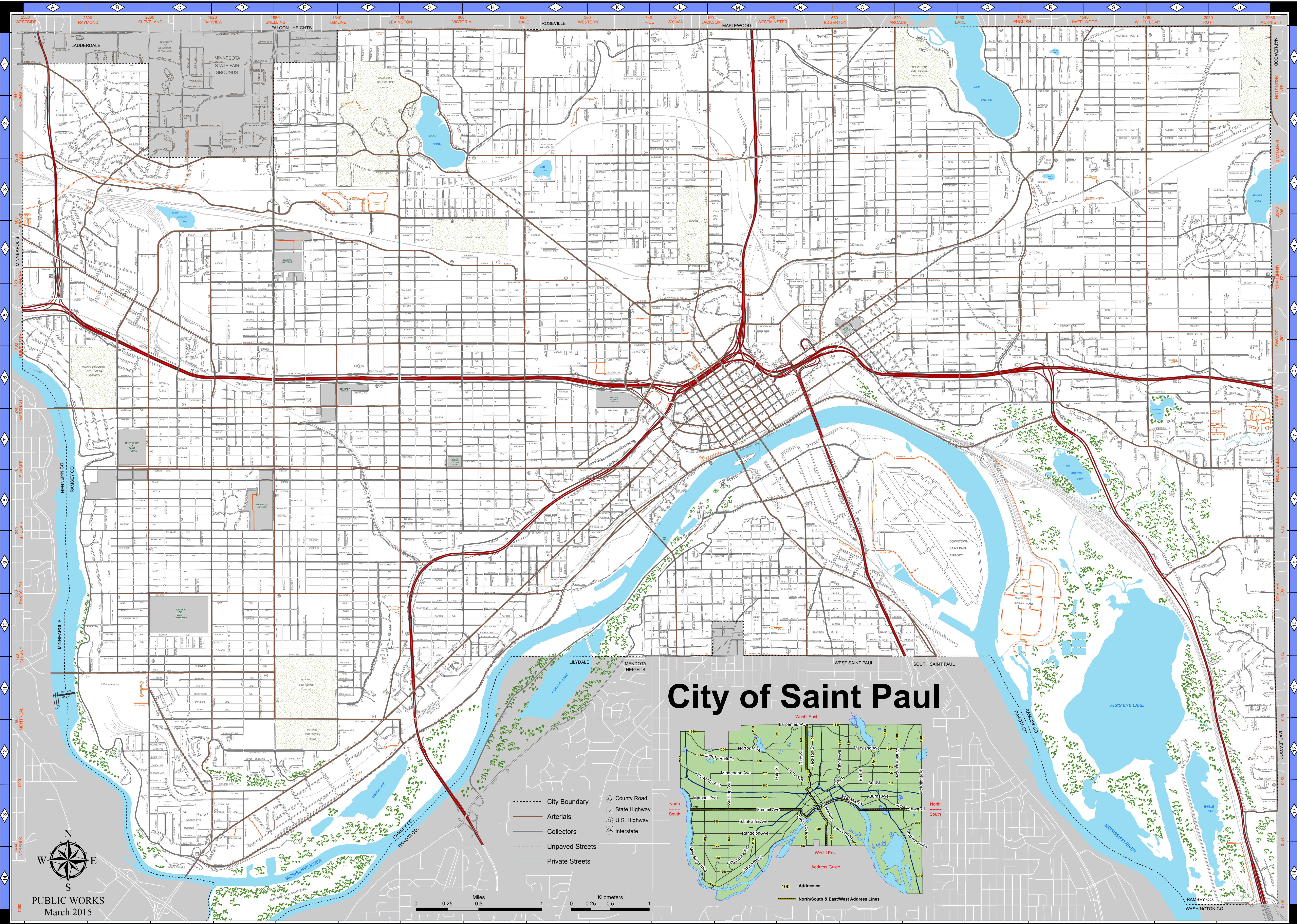
Begins the following morning, typically by 8 a.m.

Day Parking

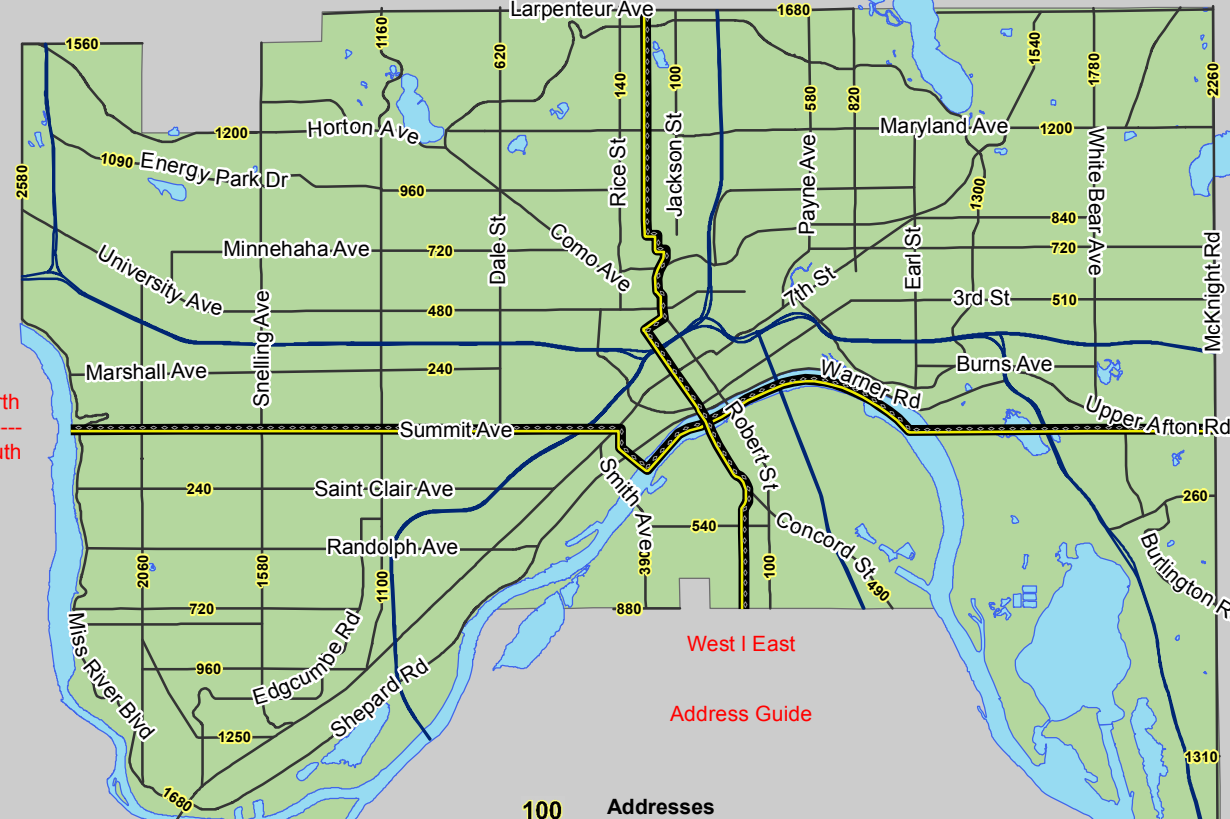
- REMEMBER: The following day, the sign is the way!**
- Parking is **NOT ALLOWED** on Day Plow Routes until the street is plowed full width.
 - Parking **IS ALLOWED** on streets with a Night Plow Route sign (provided the street has been plowed full width).
- Day Plow Routes are typically completed by 5 p.m. the day after the emergency has been declared.

- A ticket and a tow can result in substantial fees.

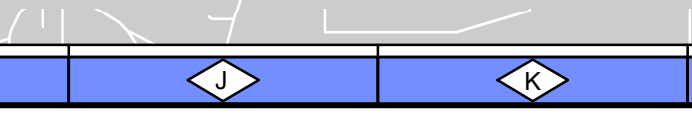
