Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 25, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A inspection will be made on May 18, 2012 at 10;45A.M. to verify the property is vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Bedroom South West Corner MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. REMOVE tv DRESER OR ANY OTHER MATERIALS THAT WOULD PREVENT ESCAPE THROUGH ESCAPE WINDOW
- 2. Bedrooms main floor MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-All windows are awning windows
- 3. South West Side SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.

- 4. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 5. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 6. MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- 7. MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.
- 8. MSFC 605.1 Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.- Bedroom south side
- 9. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work WILL require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 10. SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on FENCE sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-wooden FENCE BEHIND THE GARAGE. If this fence is yours repair the fence
- 11. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 12. SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure toilet to floor.
- 13. SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.-After securing the toilet to floor caulk the base.
- 14. SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-Also gutters . Owner states he is waiting for the insurance company to reply. Comply by May 30,2012 or submit documents that show claim has been accepted from the insurance company.
- 15. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or peeling paint.
