Sound Level Variance Application

Legislative Code Chapter 293. - Noise Regulations Application and \$178 fee should be submitted a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to the event date to allow ample time for required public notification period and scheduling of a Council public hearing. Applications submitted within sixty (60) days of the event date may not satisfy the processing timeline requirements.

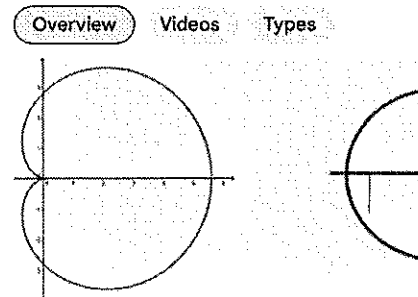
Stage Placement



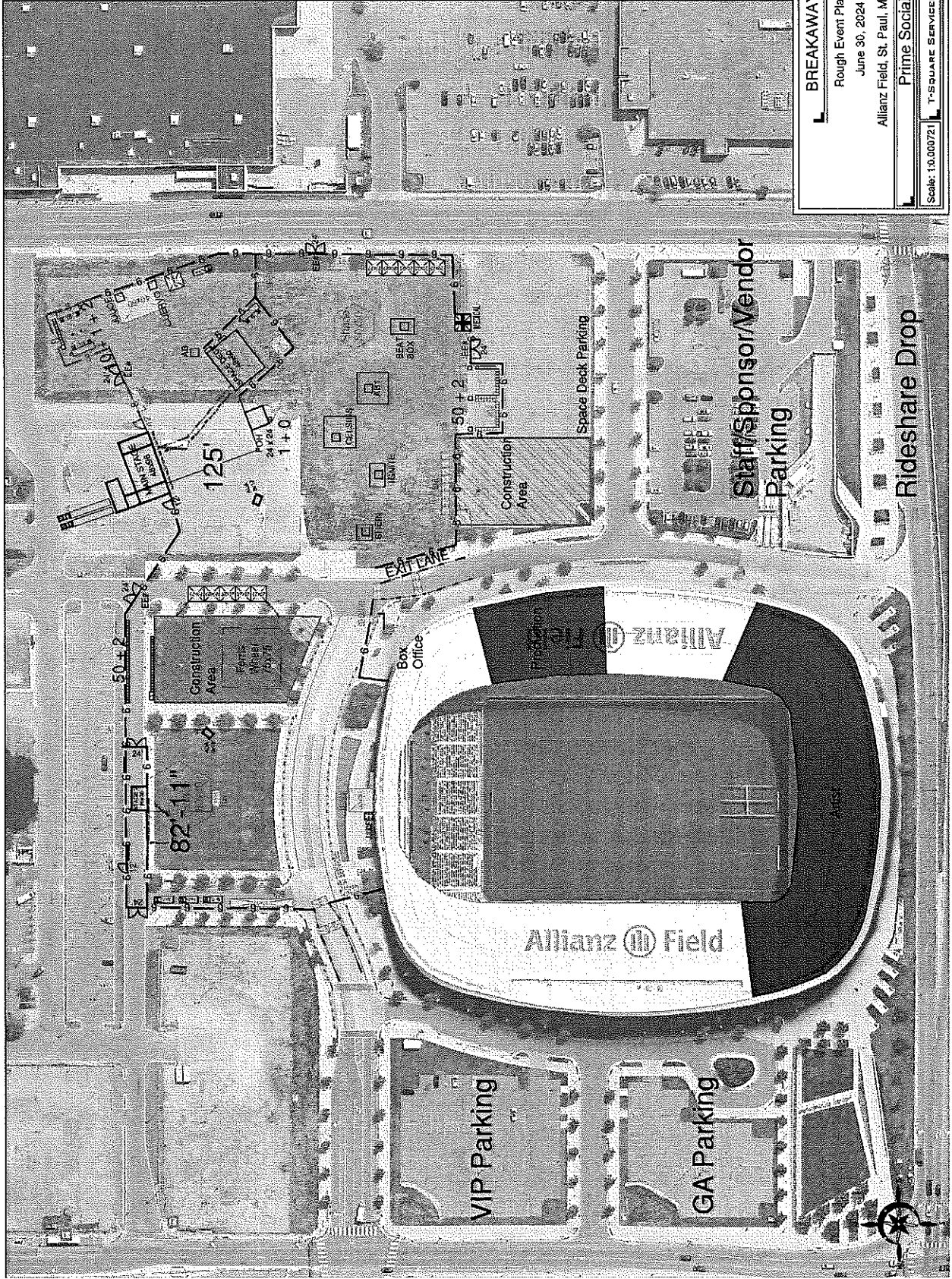
Cardioid Sub Array Arrangement

Cardioid sub array arrangement is where you aim one sub in each stack backwards and the sound waves cancel each other out so you don't get so much sub bass going out the back of the stage. See diagram to the right for additional info.

Cardioid



A cardioid is a heart-shaped plane figure. It is a curve which is defined as the locus of a point lying on the circumference of a circle that is rolling externally without any slip on the boundary of another circle of the same radius.
