**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
Sound Level Variance  
St Paul Triathlon – Lake Phalen Park

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

**Description of Variance:**

**Location:** Lake Phalen Park

**Noise Source:** Judi Fluger, Midwest Multisport Races LLC, has requested a sound level variance, at no specified sound level limit or distance, to provide the use of a sound system for amplified DJ music and announcements at Phalen Park for the St Paul Triathlon event. The variance is requested for the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., on Saturday, August 17, 2019. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., for the St. Paul Triathlon on Saturday, August 17, 2019. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. The applicant may need to provide a barrier, to act as a sound absorber, to contain excess sound from leaving the area 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 2:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
