Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 18, 2010 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on November 19, 2010 at 10:30 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 1231 Back steps MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove furniture and storage from hallway.
- 2. 1231 Basement steps SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the damaged handrail in an approved manner.-Properly secure the handrail.
- 3. 1231 SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Properly secure the toilet to the <u>floor</u>.

- 4. 1231 SPLC 34.09 (3) i Repair and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock. Gide 6600 1231
- 5. All sleeping rooms MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 6. Basement 1229 and 1231 UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 7. Basement MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.
- 8. Basement SPC 4715.1800.9, 2210 Provide pressure relief valve for hot water heater piped to within 18 inches of the floor. 1219
- 9. Garage facing the alley. SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. (HN-1)-Provide reflective numbers or background or illuminate at night.
- 10. Living room 1229 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls. Paint the wall in a professional manner.
- 11. Throughout MSFC 901.6 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service Replace
- Throughout MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.All bedrooms

All bedrooms 21.5 h x 26 w Glazed 7.7 sq ft

- 13. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 14. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
