
To Whom it may concern,

To Whom It May Concern:

We reside next door to 856 Albemarle Street. From the windows on the south side of the house you have a view of the garage and back yard at 856 Albemarle. The garage and back yard are also visible from our 2nd floor east facing bathroom window. The garage is also visible from the back yard and driveway of 860 Albemarle. We can testify that up to October 2, 2012 there was a door on the garage and that door had a lock and door knob on it.

On October 2nd, 2012 at 6:00 a.m. Barbara Alt took Crystal Graves to her place of employment and then Barbara went to the laundromat. Sharon Alt noticed that the garage door at 856 Albemarle was open. When Barbara returned home around 9:00 a.m., she also noticed that the garage door was kicked in and was off the hinges. Barbara walked up the driveway to see if the 856 Albemarle house was broken into, it was not; however, the garage door was off its hinges and the door was in the garage.

Roughly one hour after Barbara had arrived home; from the upstairs bathroom window Barbara and Sharon saw a man and woman from the 4 plex apartment building at 157 Atwater Street hauling stuff (garbage bags and boxes filled with stuff, couch, etc.) from the 4 plex apartment building. The man and woman crossed an empty lot owned by the city and put their stuff into the garage at 856 Albemarle. Barbara phoned the police to report the trespassing and illegally dumping. Police arrived and talked to the man. Barbara and Sharon heard the police order the man to remove the items and to carry them back to 157 Atwater Street.

Upon Crystal's return home from work at 3:40 p.m. she and Barbara saw the man and woman still removing the items from the garage and carrying them to 157 Atwater Street.
