#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Upstairs - SPLC 34.13 (1) - Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over half the floor area. Upstairs room ceilings are 6 foot 8 inches at highest. Room is 191.5 square feet with ceiling at or above 5 feet. Room has 134 square feet at 6 foot 8 inches. Room cannot be used as a sleeping area. Remove bed from room.

2. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke alarm affidavit and return it to this office.
