On 8/31/19 at 0157 hours, we, squad 120 (Wallace, Campbell) were at 1347 University, BP Gas Station for a proactive police visit when we observed 5-7 females physically fighting in the parking lot on the North side.

Officers gave clear, loud, verbal commands to stop fighting. Several commands were given but the group continued to fight each other. Due to the number of people involved and the rapid changing hostile environment, Officer Campbell and I deployed a small amount of ASR to the area of where the fight was occurring. We continued to give verbal commands as we assessed the situation.

The group of fighters stopped physically fighting and went in separate ways, ending the incident without having to escalate our use of force to control the situation. No one appeared to be injured and no one requested medics.

We stood by for several minutes as the parking lot was cleared out of approximately 30 vehicles.

I requested security camera footage from the store clerk requesting video from 0145 to 0200 hours.

Nothing further.

On 8/31/19 at 0157 hours, squad 120 observed several people fighting at 1347 University Ave, BP Gas Station. The group was disbursed without incident.

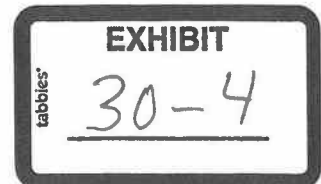

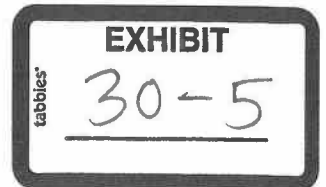

On 08/31/2019 at 0157 hours, we (Campbell/Wallace - 120) were conducting a PPV at 1347 University Ave W (BP Gas) station due to a large crowd growing in the parking lot.

While actively patrolling the parking lot in a fully marked squad car, we overheard what appeared to be loud yelling occurring to the rear of our location. We turned our squad car, which was located on the northwest corner of the parking lot, to observed roughly six to eight individuals actively fighting.

My partner (Officer Wallace) who was in the passenger seat operating the radio on this particular night radioed our observation as we drove closer.

As we stopped and exited our vehicle, both myself and my partner (Wallace) told the individuals to stop fighting. At roughly 6-8 ft away, I deployed my ASR from my duty belt and deployed it in the vicinity of the crowd. I aimed to the best of my ability at the individuals clearly displaying aggressive behavior.

After deploying my ASR for roughly three to five seconds I stopped and evaluated the situation. After a few moments, I observed that the ASR had little to no effect as the individuals continued to fight. I then administered another three to five second burst of ASR to the area in which the people were fighting.

It should be noted that I was unable to make contact with the parties fighting as a vehicle blocked my path. The second round of ASR deployment was conducted as I reached over a unoccupied parked vehicle.

After administering two rounds of ASR, the chemical agent seemed to have successfully deterred all occupants from fighting. We remained on scene and encouraged people in the area to leave. No parties were able to be arrested or identified due to many of the parties quickly getting into vehicles and leaving the area.

Deployment of the ASR was effective due to no individuals or Officers being injured while breaking up and dispersing the fight.

Once the lot and surrounding area had been cleared, we spoke with Sgt. Bisson who was on scene and made him aware that ASR was administered.

All required reports were completed.

Watch Commander and West Sergeant were made aware of incident.

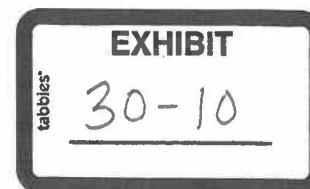

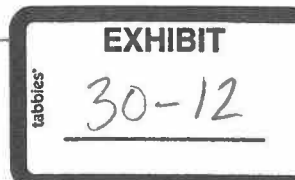

this investigation on this call. I did not review my BWC recording prior to writing this report, but may review the footage at a later time.

On 09/04/2019 at 2132 hours, I squad 165 (Noesen) was dispatched to a Drunk Person at 1347 University Ave W (BP). Dispatch notes read the complainant, later identified as YASIN MOHAMAD FARAH (DOB: 01/01/1973; 568 Lexington Parkway Apt 4, St Paul 55106; UNK PHONE) was being robbed at the address. No robbery occurred during the time of the incident.

When I arrived, I located FARAH inside the store. FARAH eyes were bloodshot and could not form a complete sentence when officers asked what happened. From what officers could understand, FARAH stated he was robbed of the tobacco. When asking him where the incident occurred, FARAH would trail off slurring his speech. When officers asked who robbed him, FARAH could not give a name or description on the suspect(s)

I spoke with the night clerk CARLOS MAURICIO at 2155 hrs and requested a video. He stated that only the manager during the day could provide me a video and he was not in right now. I gave him my business card with the date and CN.

FARAH was transported to his residence (568 Lexington Pwky, Apt 4) by Squad 169 (Ofc. Graham/Ofc. Sheehy) without incident.

No further information at this time.

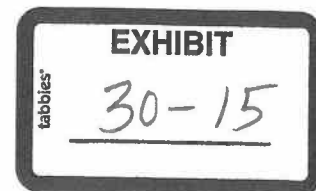

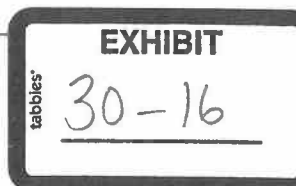

FINGER was barely coherent. I could see he had some scratches and apparently minor injuries on his face. Medic 14 (run 39394) responded to the scene. They transported FINGER to regions hospital.

Officer A. Lyfoung went inside the gas station to check on possible video of the incident. He told me they were unable to provide video at this time.

I went to Regions Hospital and attempted to speak with FINGER. The little bit of information I could gather is that he had been smoking marijuana and drinking last night. FINGER indicated he was robbed in the parking lot of BP. He used gestures and spoke slightly to indicate two people had robbed him. FINGER indicated his car keys and \$40 cash had been stolen.

I (Sergeant Soren Mahowald) am assigned to the Homicide Unit for the St. Paul Police Department, and was assigned this case for review and investigation. I began by reviewing all of the included reports and information, as well as any pictures if applicable. The reports on all parties involved were reviewed to determine the course of investigation, as well as the level and probability of solvability. This is all done for information gathering purposes, as well as possible future criminal charges.

On 9-12-19, I attempted multiple times to contact the complainant Derrick HOOD c/p 651-494-2613 with negative results, the phone rings once and there is no option to leave a message.

I reviewed multiple CCTV surveillance videos of the area of the BP at 1347 University Ave. One surveillance video shows that the complainant (HOOD) retrieving an unknown object (I suspect the hammer he described in the original report) from the blue sedan, and he lifts it up and runs towards the group of black males and females, who quickly back up. The group responds by grabbing unknown objects and crates and throwing them at HOOD and the blue sedan. The blue sedan then pulls away from the parking spot and circles around the BP. HOOD then runs into the store, some of the group follow him into the store.

As of today I have not received any further information from the store manager at BP indicating that there is video of the incident from inside the store.

This case will be pended until any further pertinent information becomes available. The case will be re-opened if a suspect identification is made or if other leads are revealed.

On 09/01/2019 at approximately 2117 hours, I, Officer S. Jones (SQD 128), responded to the BP gas station at 1347 University Avenue W for a report of a 911 hang-up.

Upon my arrival, I observed Metro Transit Police at the west bound light rail platform with a group of individuals. After driving through the BP lot, I pulled over and spoke with Metro Transit Police and they advised that there was a disorderly male on the platform wearing a green shirt that was bleeding from the face but was not cooperative with them. Metro Transit stated that they have dealt with the male, later identified as DEREK ARMAND CLAYTOR (DOB: 09/13/1971; 2700 UNIVERSITY AVENUE W APT 314; C/P: UNKNOWN), multiple times and every time they have dealt with him he has been uncooperative. Metro Transit Police stated that they asked the male if he needed an ambulance and CLAYTOR stuck up his middle finger at the officer and walked away.

While I was talking with Metro Transit Police, a group of uncooperative juveniles walked passed and stated that CLAYTOR attempted to "rob" the BP gas station and was struck in the face by a crowbar.

I then went and spoke with the clerk, CARLOS EDUARDO MAURICIO (DOB: 01/26/1969; 2620 PORTLAND AVENUE S, MINNEAPOLIS, MN, 55407; C/P: 612-407-6310), who stated that CLAYTOR has stolen from the store on seven occasions. MAURICIO stated that CLAYTOR attempted to steal a pair of headphones from the store. MAURICIO stated that he exited the glass box that he was working behind with a crowbar. MAURICIO stated that he confronted CLAYTOR and attempted to push CLAYTOR out of the store with the crowbar. MAURICIO stated that CLAYTOR grabbed the crowbar and started to push back. MAURICIO then struck CLAYTOR in the face with the crowbar. MAURICIO stated that CLAYTOR then left the store.

MAURICIO recovered the stolen property.

I collected the crowbar that MAURICIO used to strike CLAYTOR.

I demanded surveillance footage of the incident from MAURICIO at 2133 hours. MAURICIO stated that only his manager is able to review and burn the surveillance footage, but stated that he would advise him. I provided MAURICIO with a business card with a case number and the time the surveillance footage was demanded.

I then exited the store and saw that Metro Transit Police had called for medics to respond for CLAYTOR'S injuries. Medic #14 (run #33732) responded and attempted to speak with CLAYTOR who was uncooperative and not forth coming with information. CLAYTOR demanded that the ambulance transport him to the hospital for "stitches."

I attempted to get information from CLAYTOR, however, he was not forth coming with information. I asked CLAYTOR if I could take photographs of his injuries, which he agreed to do. I took a couple of photographs of

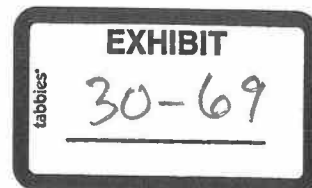

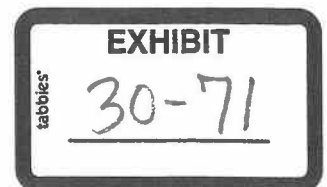

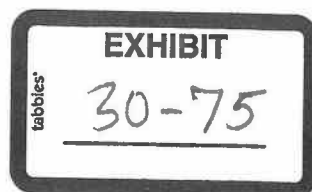

On 08/24/2019 at 2250 hours SQD 126 OFF SCHELLINGER was dispatched to 1346 Sherburne Ave on a report of an assault and criminal damage to property. Upon arrival I met with the victim MOHAMMAD AWAD, (1/13/998, 651-502-6149), his cousin WALID NAJAJRA (11/13/200, 909-609-8911) and his uncle, KHADER SAFI (04/21/1983, 651-246-2975).

AWAD stated that he walked into the alley behind 1346 University Ave and saw a late teens early 20's B/F wearing a short skirt behind his house and asked her what she was doing. The female stated that she was going to use the bathroom on his property and AWAD argued with her. AWAD stated that the female was accompanied by a late teens to early 20's B/M who was approximately 6'2" with a heavy build wearing a green baseball cap and black shirt.

The Male suspect pushed AWAD to the ground and kicked him. AWAD's, NAJAJRA cousin, came out of the rear of the house and saw the incident and grabbed a broom to defend AWAD. The male and female suspect left and came back with two more men who were described as short black males. The suspects threw rocks at AWAD and NAJAJRA. Rocks were also thrown through the rear windshield of AWAD's car, a red 2009 Toyota Camry.

The suspects fled south toward University Ave. AWAD stated that he has seen the tall heavy male suspects before at 1347 University Ave. AWAD seemed worried because the group stated that they were going to come back later. I advised AWAD to call SPPD if he sees the suspects again. I provided AWAD my business card with the case number.

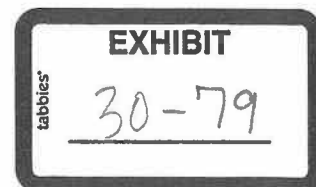

I, Sergeant Schwab, have reviewed the video provided by CCTV in this case. On 09-11-2019 I shared a still shot of the suspect from the video that is wearing a hat. Mr. Awad looked at that picture and told me if the male was wearing a hat that he is likely the person that assaulted him, but he wasn't sure.

I attempted to identify the male in the photo sent by Western District Patrol Officers as well as FORCE patrol officers that regularly responded to calls for service at the BP Station. I did not receive a positive response on an ID.

Time stamps on the video:

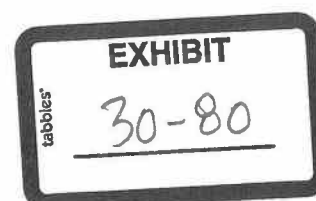
2234:37 - Mr. Awad is observed entering the gas pump side of the BP. He is on his cell phone.

2234:58 - Mr. Awad approaches a group of four people who are standing by a red/maroon vehicle with its headlights on. He speaks to two of the males. The males he speaks to appear to be younger. One is on a bike with a doo-rag. The other is in a white T-Shirt and red pants.

2235:07 - Mr. Awad receives something from the male in the white T-Shirt and walks away, back towards his home.

The call for service came in at 2240:30 which means the assault took place between Mr. Awad walking away and calling the police (5 minutes). The assault likely took place shortly after Mr. Awad walks away from the BP.

2235:31 - The male that handed Mr. Awad something (BM White T-shirt and red pants) walks out of the camera view towards the direction of Mr. Awad's home. Other juvenile males that are on bicycles also walk in that direction.

2236:46 - Several of the juvenile males that had gone in the direction of Mr. Awads home are now observed coming back (from the north to the south) and looking back to the south.

2236:52 - The male with the white T-shirt and red pants arrives back at the red car that he had been standing at. He gets in the passenger seat, and the car leaves the area.

2237:44 - - The male with the hat that was previously shown to Mr. Awad by myself does not enter the video until this time. The assault is likely over at this point. Based on this I believe the male with the hat is not involved. He approaches from University into the lot of the BP.

Still shots of the male in the white T-shirt and red pants as well as the juveniles in the area at the time of this incident were shared with Western Patrol District Officers as well as FORCE Unit Officers to identify anyone else that was there. I received no positive response back to identify them.

It should be noted that because there was no clothing description, I am unable to identify the initial person that assaulted him. It is unknown if this person was at the BP prior to the assault. There is no male matching the approximate 35yoa with a green baseball hat description ever in the video.

As of this date, I have not received any new information on this incident, and do not have any leads to pursue at this time. I will continue to wait for any possible "hits" or results from the still shots sent to patrol and Force. All solvability factors have been exhausted. This case will be pended until any further pertinent information becomes available. The case will be re-opened if a suspect identification is made or if other leads are revealed.

I, SGT Schwab, spoke to the victim in this case (Mohammed Awad) and learned he was seen at the hospital after this incident. I requested he come to HQ to sign a medical release. At 1630 hours Mohammed Awad 01-13-1998 arrived. I recorded our conversation and later uploaded it to the media vault.

Awad's left arm was in a black sling. He was taken to St Joseph's in St Paul by his uncle. The doctor told him his arm was not broken, that it was sprained and that it would heal and the pain would go away in three to four days. He was prescribed medication.

Regarding the incident Awad told me the following:

His home (1346 Sherburne) is directly behind the BP Gas Station at Hamline and University (1347 University). On 8-24-2019 he walked to the BP and returned home at approximately 2230 hours to find his cousin Walid Najaijra having words with a black male and black female. Awad said when he approached them in the driveway the black male pushed him to the ground. Awad put his left arm out to break his fall. He hurt his left arm in the process. Once on the ground this male kicked him 3-4 times and then sprayed an unknown irritant onto Awad. Awad knew what "mace" was and doesn't believe it was mace. He is unsure what the chemical was. He showed me pictures of the effect the chemical had on his arm. I saw raised red bumps on both of his arms.

Awad described the male that pushed him down, kicked him, and sprayed him with the chemical as:

- Black male
- Shaved head
- 16-17yoa
- 5-7 to 5-9

After being assaulted by the above mentioned suspect Awad said this male then yelled over to a group of people at the BP. He said about 5 males began to come towards him. He remained on the ground. He said a
